2. GETTING STARTED

- Motorola ThinkPhone (2023)
- TurboPower 68W charger
- USB Type-C cable (or USB Type-C to USB Type-C cable)

- SIM tool
- Guides

2.2. Inserting the SIM Card

1. Locate the SIM tray on the side of your phone.
2. Insert the provided SIM tool into the small hole next to the tray to eject it.
3. Place your Nano-SIM card(s) into the tray with the gold contacts facing down.
4. Carefully reinsert the tray into the phone.

2.3. Initial Setup

Upon first power-on, follow the on-screen instructions to:

- Select your language and region.
- Connect to a Wi-Fi network.
- Sign in with your Google account.
- Set up security features like fingerprint unlock or facial recognition.
- Transfer data from an old device (optional).

3. DEVICE OVERVIEW

3.1. Physical Features

The Motorola ThinkPhone features an aircraft-grade aluminum frame and aramid fiber construction for durability. It is MIL STD 810H-tested and IP68-certified for water and dust resistance.

- **Front:** 6.6-inch FHD+ (2400 x 1080) 402ppi display with Gorilla Glass Victus protection.
- **Right Side:** Power button, Volume rocker.
- **Left Side:** Quick Button (programmable).
- **Bottom:** USB-C port, Speaker grille, SIM tray.
- **Back:** Dual camera module, Motorola logo.

3.2. Display

The device features a 6.6-inch P-OLED display with a 144 Hz refresh rate, offering smooth visuals and vibrant colors for an enhanced viewing experience.

Capture more in your shots with the ultra-wide camera, perfect for landscapes and group photos. It also supports macro vision for detailed close-up photography.

4.3. Video Recording

Record high-quality videos with stabilization. The phone supports 4K video recording at 30 frames per second (fps) and 1080p at 60 fps.

The ThinkPhone supports 68W TurboPower wired charging, allowing you to get a full day's power in just 15 minutes. It also supports 15W wireless charging. The included TurboPower 68W charger and USB Type-C cable are designed for fast and efficient charging.

- **Clear app cache:** If a specific app is misbehaving, try clearing its cache. Go to *Settings > Apps > See all apps > [App Name] > Storage & cache > Clear cache*.
- **Factory reset (last resort):** If problems persist, you may need to perform a factory reset. **Warning:** This will erase all data on your phone. Back up important data before proceeding. Go to *Settings > System > Reset options > Erase all data (factory reset)*.
- **Contact Support:** If you cannot resolve the issue, refer to the Warranty and Support section for further assistance.

9. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Motorola ThinkPhone, follow these care guidelines:

- **Keep it clean:** Regularly wipe your phone with a soft, lint-free cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- **Protect the screen:** The Gorilla Glass Victus offers impact resistance, but a screen protector and case are recommended for added protection.
- **Avoid extreme temperatures:** Do not expose your phone to very high or low temperatures.
- **Water and dust resistance:** While IP68-certified, avoid intentional submersion in water or exposure to excessive dust. Ensure all ports are dry before charging.
