## INTRODUCTION

## SETUP GUIDE

### 1. Initial Power-On and Windows Setup

1. **Unpack the Laptop:** Carefully remove the laptop and all accessories from the packaging.
2. **Connect Power:** Plug the power adapter into the laptop's power port and then into a wall outlet.
3. **Power On:** Open the laptop lid and press the power button, typically located on the top right of the keyboard.
4. **Windows 11 Pro Setup:** Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the initial setup of Windows 11 Pro. This includes selecting your region, language, connecting to a Wi-Fi network, and creating a user account.

### 2. Connecting Peripherals

Your Lenovo IdeaPad 3 offers various ports for connecting external devices.

- **USB Devices:** Use the USB-A 3.2 Gen 1, USB-A 2.0, or USB-C 3.2 Gen 1 ports for connecting external drives, keyboards, mice, or other USB accessories.
- **External Display:** Connect an external monitor or TV using the HDMI port.
- **Audio:** Use the Headphone/Microphone Combo jack for headphones or external microphones.

- **SD Cards:** Insert SD memory cards into the built-in SD Media Card Reader for data transfer.

### Display and Interaction

- **15.6" FHD Touchscreen:** The laptop features a 15.6-inch Full HD (1920 x 1080) IPS anti-glare touchscreen display. This allows for direct interaction with the screen using touch gestures, in addition to traditional mouse and keyboard input.
- **Keyboard and Touchpad:** Utilize the full-size keyboard with a numeric keypad for typing and the integrated touchpad for navigation.
- **Webcam:** The integrated 720p webcam with a built-in microphone is suitable for video calls and online meetings.

## MAINTENANCE AND CARE

### General Care

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a screen cleaner to clean the display. For the keyboard and chassis, use a dry, soft cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- **Handling:** Always handle the laptop with care. Avoid dropping it or placing heavy objects on it.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure the laptop's vents are not obstructed to prevent overheating. Use the laptop on a hard, flat surface.

### Software Updates

- **Windows Updates:** Regularly check for and install Windows updates to ensure your operating system has the latest security patches and features. Go to *Settings > Windows Update*.
- **Driver Updates:** Keep your device drivers updated for optimal performance. Lenovo provides driver updates through their official support website or Lenovo Vantage software.

### Battery Care

- **Charging:** Use only the original Lenovo power adapter. Avoid fully discharging the battery frequently.
- **Storage:** If storing the laptop for an extended period, ensure the battery is charged to about 50-60%.

## TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

- **Laptop Not Powering On:**

  - Close unnecessary applications and browser tabs.
  - Check for and install any pending Windows updates.
  - Run a disk cleanup and defragmentation (for HDD, though SSDs don't need defragging, cleanup is still useful).
  - Ensure adequate ventilation to prevent thermal throttling.
- **Wi-Fi Connectivity Issues:**
  - Restart your router and modem.
  - Disable and re-enable Wi-Fi on your laptop.
  - Check if Wi-Fi drivers are up to date.
  - Ensure you are within range of your Wi-Fi network.

- **Touchscreen Not Responding:**

- Restart the laptop.
- Check for updated display drivers.
- Ensure the screen is clean and free of debris.
