1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the CAMECHO Android 13 Car Stereo. This manual provides detailed instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your new car multimedia system. This unit features a 7-inch HD touchscreen, integrated Bluetooth, WiFi, GPS, USB, FM/RDS radio, Mirror Link functionality, and steering wheel control compatibility. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure proper operation and to maximize your driving experience.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Professional Installation Recommended:** Installation of car audio equipment requires technical knowledge. It is highly recommended to have this unit installed by a qualified professional.
- **Power Supply:** Ensure the car stereo is connected to a 12V DC power supply with negative grounding. Incorrect voltage can damage the unit.
- **Wiring:** Carefully follow the wiring diagram. Incorrect wiring can cause malfunctions or damage to the vehicle's electrical system.
- **Driving Safety:** Do not operate the unit in a way that distracts you from driving. Always prioritize road safety.
- **Temperature:** Avoid exposing the unit to extreme temperatures or direct sunlight for prolonged periods.
- **Moisture:** Keep the unit away from water and excessive moisture to prevent electrical hazards.



5.2 Installation Process

The installation process involves removing the original car radio and connecting the new unit. Due to variations in vehicle models and wiring, professional installation is strongly recommended.

General Steps (Consult a professional for specific vehicle instructions):

1. **Disconnect Battery:** Always disconnect the negative terminal of your car battery before starting any electrical work.
2. **Remove Old Unit:** Carefully remove the trim panels and the existing car radio from the dashboard.
3. **Connect Wiring Harness:** Connect the provided power cables, RCA cables, USB cables, and other necessary wiring harnesses to the new car stereo and the vehicle's corresponding ports. Ensure all connections are secure.
4. **GPS Antenna:** Mount the GPS antenna in a location with a clear view of the sky, typically on the dashboard or under the windshield.
5. **Radio Antenna:** Connect the radio antenna.
6. **Canbus Box:** Connect the Canbus box if your vehicle requires it for steering wheel controls or other vehicle data integration.
7. **Test Functionality:** Before fully reassembling the dashboard, reconnect the car battery and test all functions of the new stereo (power, audio, radio, GPS, Bluetooth, steering wheel controls).
8. **Secure Unit:** Once confirmed working, secure the new car stereo in the dashboard and reassemble all trim panels.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Basic Operation

- **Power On/Off:** Press and hold the power button (usually the volume knob) to turn the unit on or off.
- **Volume Control:** Rotate the volume knob or use the touchscreen controls to adjust the audio level.
- **Home Screen:** Tap the 'Home' icon to return to the main menu.
- **Settings:** Access system settings via the gear icon to customize display, audio, network, and other preferences.

6.2 Radio (FM/RDS)

Access the 'Radio' application from the main menu.

- **Scan:** Use the 'Scan' function to automatically search for and save available radio stations.
- **Manual Tuning:** Manually adjust the frequency to find specific stations.

- **Presets:** Save your favorite stations to the 18 available preset slots for quick access.
- **RDS:** Radio Data System (RDS) displays station information such as station name and program type where available.

6.3 Bluetooth Connectivity

Pair your smartphone with the car stereo for hands-free communication and audio streaming.

- **Pairing:** Go to the 'Bluetooth' application. Enable Bluetooth on your phone and search for the car stereo (usually named 'CAMECHO' or similar). Select it and confirm the pairing code.
- **Hands-Free Calling:** Make and receive calls directly from the car stereo interface. Your phonebook can be synchronized.
- **Audio Streaming:** Play music from your phone through the car's speakers.

6.4 GPS Navigation

Utilize the built-in GPS for accurate navigation.

- **Map Applications:** The unit comes with pre-installed map applications or allows you to download your preferred navigation apps from the Google Play Store.
- **Online/Offline Maps:** Supports both online navigation (requires WiFi/hotspot) and offline maps (download maps in advance).

6.5 WiFi Connection

Connect to a WiFi network or mobile hotspot to access online features.

- **Connecting:** Go to 'Settings' > 'Network & Internet' > 'Wi-Fi'. Select your desired network and enter the password.
- **Online Features:** Once connected, you can browse the internet, download apps, stream music/videos, and use online navigation.

6.6 Mirror Link

Mirror your smartphone screen onto the car stereo display.

6.7 Steering Wheel Control

Configure your vehicle's steering wheel buttons to control the car stereo functions.

- **Setup:** Access the 'Steering Wheel Control' settings in the system menu. Follow the on-screen instructions to map your steering wheel buttons to the desired functions (e.g., volume up/down, track skip, mode change).

6.8 Multimedia Playback

Play audio and video files from USB drives or internal storage.

- **USB Media:** Insert a USB drive into one of the USB ports. The unit will automatically detect and allow you to browse and play media files.

7. MAINTENANCE

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No Power	Incorrect wiring; Blown fuse; Loose power connection.	Check power cables and fuse. Ensure secure connections. Consult installation professional.
No Sound	Volume too low; Mute activated; Incorrect speaker wiring; Faulty speakers.	Increase volume. Check mute status. Verify speaker connections. Test with different audio source.
Poor Radio Reception	Antenna not connected; Weak signal area; Damaged antenna.	Ensure antenna is properly connected. Try a different location. Replace antenna if damaged.
GPS Signal Issues	GPS antenna not properly placed; Obstruction; Faulty antenna.	Ensure GPS antenna has a clear view of the sky. Check antenna connection.
Bluetooth Connection Problems	Bluetooth not enabled; Incorrect pairing; Interference.	Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on both devices. Delete previous pairings and re-pair. Move closer to the unit.
Touchscreen Unresponsive	System crash; Dirt on screen.	Restart the unit. Clean the screen. If issue persists, perform a factory reset (data will be lost).
