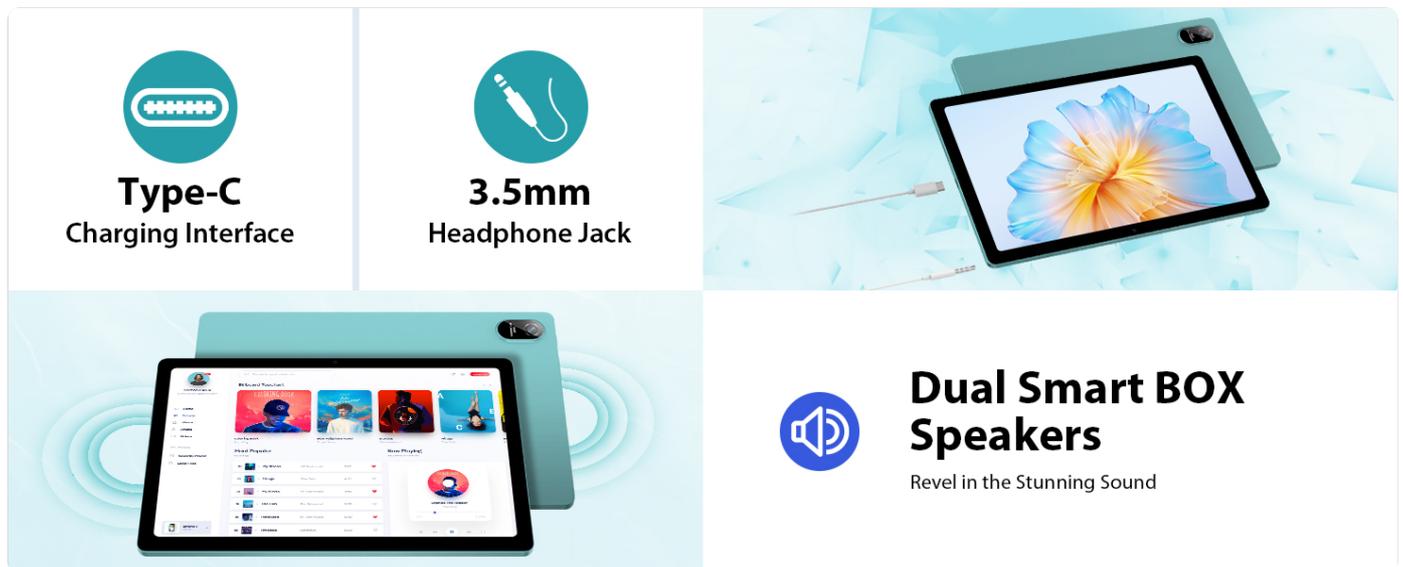


Figure 3: Key ports and audio features of the tablet, including the Type-C port, headphone jack, and speaker locations.

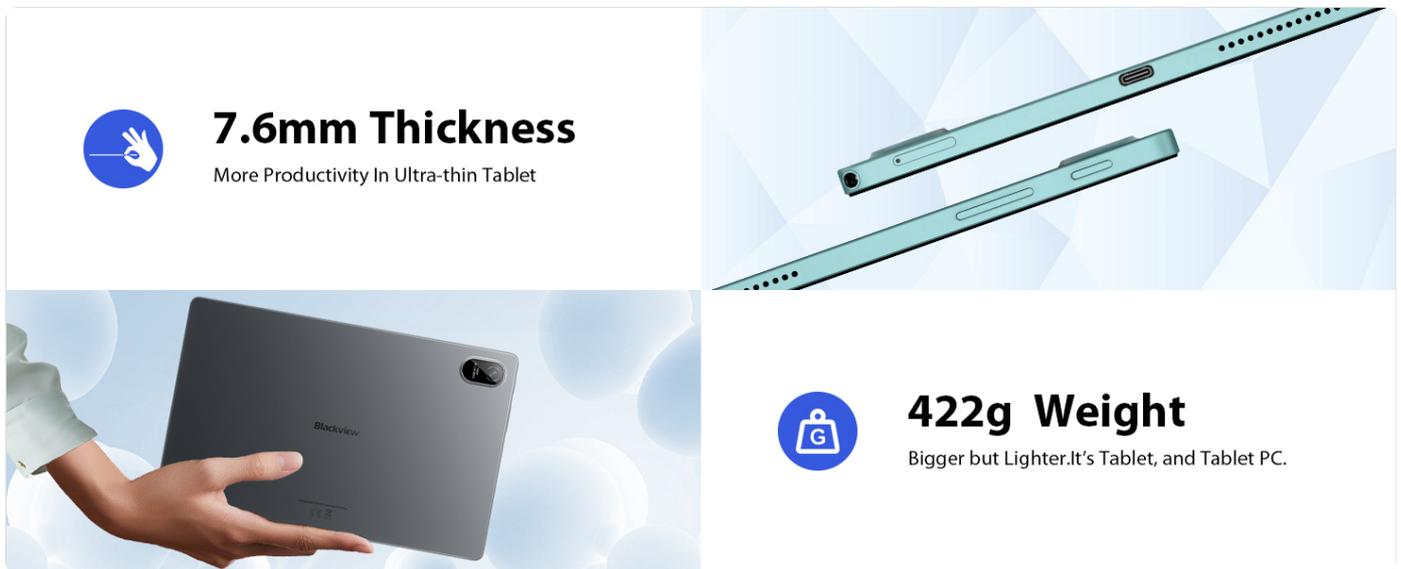


Figure 4: Physical dimensions and weight of the Blackview Tab 11 WiFi.

## SETUP

---

### 1. Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge your tablet using the provided charger and cable. Connect the Type-C cable to the tablet's charging port and the adapter to a power outlet. The battery indicator on the screen will show charging progress.

## 2. Powering On/Off

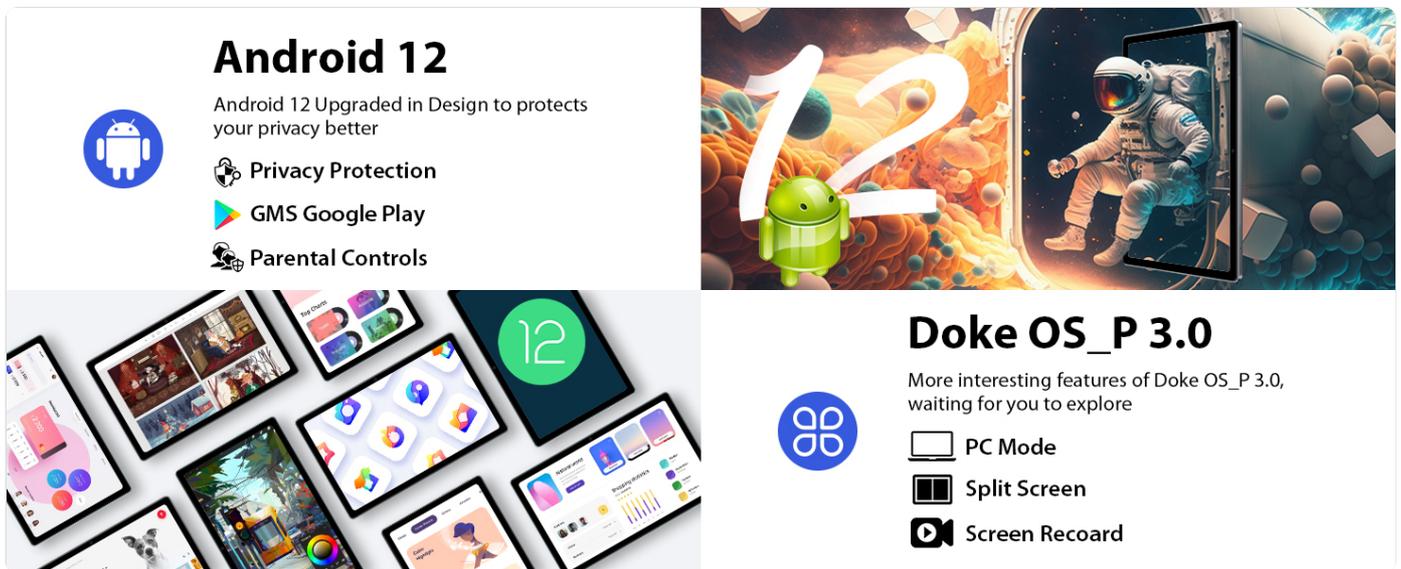


Figure 6: Android 12 operating system interface, demonstrating its features and user experience.

## MAINTENANCE

### Cleaning the Tablet

### Battery Care

- Avoid exposing the tablet to extreme temperatures (hot or cold) as this can degrade battery life.
- For optimal battery longevity, avoid frequently discharging the battery completely or keeping it at 100% charge for extended periods.
- Use only the original or certified compatible charging accessories.

### Software Updates

Regularly check for and install software updates to ensure your tablet has the latest features, security patches, and performance improvements. Go to Settings > System > System update.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your Blackview Tab 11 WiFi.

### Tablet Not Powering On

- Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the charger and wait a few minutes before attempting to power on.
- Press and hold the Power button for at least 10-15 seconds to perform a forced restart.

### Wi-Fi Connectivity Issues

- Toggle Wi-Fi off and on in Settings.
- Restart your Wi-Fi router.
- Forget the network and reconnect by re-entering the password.

### Slow Performance

- Close unused applications running in the background.
- Clear cache for frequently used apps (Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage & cache > Clear cache).
- Ensure sufficient storage space is available. Delete unnecessary files or apps.
- Restart the tablet periodically.
