INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Korg NAUTILUS88AT 88-Key Keyboard Production Station. The NAUTILUS88AT is a flagship workstation designed for musical expression, featuring Aftertouch capabilities and a comprehensive sound library.

Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure proper use and to fully utilize the advanced features of your instrument.

SETUP

Unboxing and Initial Placement

Carefully remove the NAUTILUS88AT from its packaging. Ensure all components are present. Place the workstation on a stable, flat surface. Due to its weight (approximately 50.9 pounds), it is recommended to have assistance during placement.

Connecting Power and Peripherals

Connect the provided power cord to the power input on the rear panel of the NAUTILUS88AT and then to a suitable power outlet. The workstation operates on a corded electric power source with a wattage of 40 watts.

For audio output, connect to an amplifier, mixer, or headphones using the 6.35mm Jack outputs. MIDI USB, USB Type A, and USB Type B connectors are available for connecting to computers or other MIDI devices.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Powering On and User Interface

Press the power button to turn on the workstation. The NAUTILUS88AT features a modern user interface with a streamlined design, providing fast access to thousands of sounds. The central display is touch-sensitive for intuitive navigation.

Sound Engines and Aftertouch

The NAUTILUS88AT incorporates nine powerful sound engines and class-leading effects. The 88-key version features a premium four-stage weighted hammer action with Aftertouch, offering an ultra-realistic piano playing experience and enhanced expressive control.

Dynamics Knob and Set List Mode

Utilize the Dynamics Knob to instantly control the sensitivity of the keyboard. This allows for consistent playability regardless of the performance context.

The intuitive Set List Mode enables organization of sounds and sequences required for a performance. Color-coded touch-screen buttons facilitate quick recall of Programs, Combinations, or Sequences during live use.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

To clean the exterior of your NAUTILUS88AT, use a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth with mild soap can be used, followed by a dry cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners, solvents, or waxes, as these can damage the finish and electronic components.

Storage

When not in use, store the workstation in a dust-free environment. If transporting, use a dedicated case to protect it from physical damage and environmental factors.

TROUBLESHOOTING

No Sound Output

- Ensure the power cable is securely connected and the unit is powered on.
- Verify that audio cables are correctly connected to the output jacks and to your amplifier/mixer.
- Check the volume settings on the NAUTILUS88AT and any connected audio equipment.
- If using headphones, ensure they are fully plugged into the 6.35mm jack.

Keyboard Not Responding

- Confirm the unit is powered on.

- Check if any local control or MIDI settings are preventing sound generation.
- If connected via MIDI, ensure MIDI cables are correctly connected and MIDI channels match.

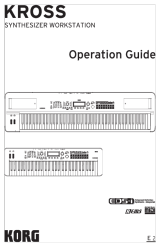
