# **VTech VT680 Cordless Phone User Manual**

#### INTRODUCTION

Welcome to your VTech VT680 Cordless Phone. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your new phone. The VTech VT680 is a DECT 6.0 cordless phone designed for reliable fixed-line communication.

Key features include Caller ID, a log of the last 10 received calls, a reminder alarm, and a 20-contact phonebook.

#### **SETUP**

## 1. Battery Installation

Step 1: Locate the battery compartment on the back of the handset.

**Step 2:** Insert the two AAA rechargeable batteries, observing the correct polarity (+ and -) as indicated inside the compartment.

**Step 3:** Close the battery compartment cover securely.

## 2. Base Unit Connection

**Step 1:** Connect one end of the telephone line cord to the TEL LINE jack on the back of the charging base.

**Step 2:** Connect the other end of the telephone line cord to your telephone wall jack.

**Step 3:** Connect the small end of the power adapter to the POWER jack on the back of the charging base.

**Step 4:** Plug the large end of the power adapter into a standard electrical outlet.

# 3. Initial Charging

Place the handset on the charging base. The handset display will show a charging indicator. Allow the handset to charge for at least 12 hours before initial use to ensure optimal battery performance and

### **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

## Making a Call

- 1. Pick up the handset or press the **PHONE** button.
- 2. Dial the desired phone number using the keypad.
- 3. Press the PHONE button again to end the call.

#### **Answering a Call**

When the phone rings, pick up the handset or press the PHONE button.

## **Using Caller ID**

When a call comes in, the caller's name and number will appear on the handset display (requires subscription to Caller ID service from your telephone provider).

To review the call log, press the **CALL LOG** button. Use the **UP** and **DOWN** arrow buttons to scroll through the last 10 received calls.

#### **Phonebook**

The phonebook can store up to 20 contacts.

### **Adding a Contact**

- 1. Press the **MENU** button.
- 2. Navigate to "Phonebook" and select "Add New Entry".
- 3. Enter the contact's name and phone number using the keypad.
- 4. Press **SAVE** to store the entry.

#### Making a Call from Phonebook

- 1. Press the **PHONEBOOK** button.
- 2. Use the UP and DOWN arrow buttons to find the desired contact.
- 3. Press the **PHONE** button to dial the contact.

#### **Setting a Reminder Alarm**

- 1. Press the **MENU** button.
- 2. Navigate to "Alarm" or "Reminders" in the menu.
- 3. Set the desired time and activate the alarm function.

#### 4. Press SAVE to confirm.

#### **M**AINTENANCE

### Cleaning

Wipe the handset and base unit with a soft, slightly damp cloth. Do not use harsh cleaning agents, abrasive materials, or excessive liquid, as these can damage the device.

## **Battery Care**

Use only the specified AAA rechargeable batteries. Replace batteries when they no longer hold a charge effectively or if you notice a significant decrease in talk time.

#### **TROUBLESHOOTING**

If you encounter any issues with your VTech VT680 Cordless Phone, please refer to the table below for common problems and their solutions.

Problem	Solution
No dial tone	Ensure the telephone line cord is securely connected to both the base unit and the telephone wall jack. Verify the power adapter is properly connected to the base unit and a working electrical outlet.
Handset not charging	Ensure the handset is correctly seated in the charging cradle. Verify the power adapter is plugged in. Clean the charging contacts on both the handset and base unit with a dry cloth.

Problem	Solution
Poor call quality or static	Move closer to the base unit. Check for interference from other electronic devices (e.g., Wi-Fi routers, microwaves). Try relocating the base unit.
Caller ID not working	Ensure you are subscribed to Caller ID service from your telephone service provider.  Contact your provider to confirm the service is active.


