1. INTRODUCTION

2. SETUP AND INITIAL USE

Your Reebok Lite 4 shoes are ready for immediate use upon unboxing. Follow these steps for initial fitting:

- 1. Unboxing:** Carefully remove the shoes from their packaging. Inspect them for any visible defects or damage.

2. **First Fit:** Wear the shoes with athletic socks. Ensure your heel is comfortably seated at the back of the shoe. There should be about a thumb's width of space between your longest toe and the end of the shoe.
3. **Lacing:** Lace the shoes securely but not too tightly. The lacing should provide a snug fit across the midfoot without causing pressure points. Adjust as needed for comfort.

physical activity, to extend the lifespan of your shoes and promote foot health.

- **Reduced Cushioning:** Over time, cushioning materials may compress. This is normal wear and tear.
- **Squeaking:** A new shoe may squeak due to friction between materials. This often resolves with wear. If persistent, ensure the insole is properly seated.


