SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. App Installation

Download the Tapo app from the App Store (iOS) or Google Play Store (Android). Create a Tapo account or log in if you already have one.

2. Hub Setup

- 1. Connect the Tapo H200 Hub to a power outlet using the provided DC power adapter.
- 2. Connect the Hub to your home router using the RJ45 Ethernet cable.
- 3. Follow the in-app instructions to add the Hub to your Tapo account.

3. Doorbell Pairing and Battery Installation

1. Insert the Tapo A100 Battery into the Tapo D230S1 Video Doorbell. Ensure it is fully charged before installation.

2. Follow the in-app instructions to pair the doorbell with the H200 Hub.

4. Physical Installation

The Tapo D230S1 offers flexible mounting options. Use the provided mounting templates, brackets, and the 15° mounting wedge to achieve the desired viewing angle and placement.

- Flat Mounting: For a direct view, mount the doorbell flat against the wall or door frame.
- Angled Mounting: Use the 15° mounting wedge to angle the doorbell horizontally, optimizing the field of view for specific entryways.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Live View and Resolution

Access the live feed of your doorbell camera through the Tapo app. The 2K 5MP resolution (2560 × 1920px) and

Starlight sensor ensure clear and detailed video, even in low-light conditions.




Image: 2K 5MP Live View Comparison. This image demonstrates the superior detail of 2K 5MP resolution compared to standard 2K, especially in low light.

2. Head-to-Toe View

The doorbell's ultra-wide 160° diagonal field of view provides a 4:3 aspect ratio live view, allowing you to see visitors from head-to-toe, even those standing close to the door.

5. Al Detection

The doorbell features AI recognition capabilities to detect people and vehicles, reducing false alerts and providing more relevant notifications.

6. Anti-Theft Alarm

An integrated anti-theft alarm will activate if someone attempts to remove the doorbell from its mounting, sending an alert to your Tapo app.





7. Storage Options

Recorded videos can be stored locally on a microSD card (up to 256 GB) inserted into the H200 Hub, or via Tapo Care cloud storage services (subscription may be required).

8. Indoor Chime

The included H200 Hub acts as an indoor chime. You can select from various ringtones and adjust the volume to ensure you hear visitors when you are home.



Choose from a variety of ringtones to get alerted immediately when you are at home.




Image: Indoor Chime Functionality. This image shows the doorbell being pressed and the sound waves emanating from the indoor chime unit, indicating an alert.


MAINTENANCE

1. Battery Management

The Tapo D230S1 features a rechargeable and removable 6700 mAh battery. The low power consumption protocol extends its operational life. Monitor the battery level through the Tapo app and recharge as needed using the provided USB adapter and cable.

Different wedge choices give users possibities to make the doorbell suits more placement scenarios. Users can also use the wedges to adjust the views.

2. Cleaning

To maintain optimal performance, periodically clean the doorbell's camera lens and exterior with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

3. Weather Resistance

The doorbell is rated IP64 for water and dust resistance, ensuring reliable operation in various weather conditions, including rain and humid environments.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **No Power/Not Turning On:** Ensure the battery is correctly inserted and fully charged. Verify the H200 Hub is properly connected to power.
- No Video/Poor Quality: Check your Wi-Fi connection strength. Ensure the camera lens is clean and free from obstructions.
- Notifications Not Received: Verify app notification settings on your smartphone and within the Tapo app.

Ensure the doorbell is connected to the Hub and has a stable internet connection.

- **Doorbell Not Ringing:** Check the volume settings for the indoor chime (H200 Hub) in the Tapo app. Ensure the doorbell is properly paired with the Hub.
- **Difficulty Pairing:** Ensure the Hub is online and within range of the doorbell. Try resetting the doorbell and Hub if issues persist.
