## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your DELUX GM905DB Wireless Ergonomic Keyboard. Designed for comfort and efficiency, this keyboard features a split ergonomic structure, dual-mode connectivity (2.4G wireless and Bluetooth), and a built-in wrist rest to support natural typing posture and reduce strain.

## 3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The DELUX GM905DB keyboard is engineered to provide a comfortable typing experience. Its key features include:

- **Split Ergonomic Design:** The keyboard is divided into two sections, allowing for a more natural hand and wrist position.
- **Integrated Wrist Rest:** A soft, pillowed wrist rest made of skin-friendly synthetic leather supports your palms during typing.
- **Dual-Mode Connectivity:** Connect wirelessly via 2.4G USB receiver or Bluetooth 5.0 (BT1, BT2 channels).
- **Multi-Device Support:** Seamlessly switch between up to three connected devices.
- **Dedicated Multimedia Keys:** Easy access to volume, brightness, and other media controls.
- **Adjustable Kickstands:** Customize the keyboard's tilt angle for optimal comfort.





Image 3.1: Illustration of the split ergonomic structure promoting a natural arm angle for comfortable typing.

Image 3.2: The full-size layout of the keyboard, featuring 112 keys and an ergonomic form factor.




Image 3.3: A close-up view of the dedicated multimedia control keys located on the keyboard.

## 4. SETUP

### 4.1. Battery Installation

The keyboard requires two AAA batteries (not included). To install:

1. Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the keyboard.
2. Open the battery compartment cover.
3. Insert two AAA batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

### 4.2. Connecting via 2.4G Wireless

To connect using the 2.4G USB receiver:

1. Insert the USB 2.4G receiver into an available USB port on your computer.
2. Turn on the keyboard.
3. Press the '2.4G' button on the keyboard. The indicator light will illuminate, confirming the connection.

### 4.3. Connecting via Bluetooth

The keyboard supports two Bluetooth channels (BT1 and BT2). To connect:

1. Turn on the keyboard.
2. Press and hold either the 'BT1' or 'BT2' button for 3-5 seconds until the corresponding indicator light flashes rapidly. This indicates pairing mode.
3. On your device (computer, tablet, etc.), navigate to Bluetooth settings and search for new devices.
4. Select 'DELUX Keyboard' (or similar name) from the list of available devices to pair.
5. Once paired, the indicator light will stop flashing and remain solid for a few seconds, then turn off.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 5.1. Switching Between Connected Devices

To switch between devices connected via 2.4G, BT1, or BT2, simply press the corresponding button ('2.4G', 'BT1', or 'BT2') on the keyboard. The keyboard will connect to the selected device.

### 5.2. Using Multimedia Keys

The keyboard features dedicated multimedia keys for quick access to various functions:

- **Volume Control:** Use the dedicated volume up, volume down, and mute buttons.
- **Brightness Control:** Adjust screen brightness with the dedicated brightness keys.
- **FN Lock:** Some function keys (F1-F12) may have secondary functions. Use the Fn key in combination with these keys, or use an Fn-lock feature if available, to toggle between primary and secondary functions.

### 5.3. Adjusting Keyboard Angle

The keyboard is equipped with adjustable kickstands to modify its tilt angle for personalized comfort. There are four kickstands located at the corners of the keyboard. Adjust them to achieve 0°, 3°, or 5° tilt as preferred for seated or standing postures.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

### 6.1. Cleaning

To clean your keyboard:

- Ensure the keyboard is turned off before cleaning.
- Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a mild cleaning solution.
- Avoid excessive moisture and do not spray cleaners directly onto the keyboard.
- For dust and debris between keys, use compressed air.

### 6.2. Battery Replacement

When the keyboard's performance degrades or the connection becomes unstable, it may be time to replace the AAA batteries. Follow the battery installation steps in Section 4.1.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Keyboard not connecting via 2.4G	USB receiver not properly inserted; low keyboard battery; incorrect mode selected.	Ensure USB receiver is fully inserted. Replace batteries. Press the '2.4G' button. Try a different USB port.
Keyboard not connecting via Bluetooth	Keyboard not in pairing mode; device Bluetooth off; low keyboard battery.	Press and hold 'BT1' or 'BT2' to enter pairing mode. Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your device. Replace batteries. Remove and re-pair the keyboard in device settings.
Keys are unresponsive or laggy	Low keyboard battery; interference; distance from receiver/device.	Replace batteries. Move closer to the receiver/device. Ensure no large metal objects are between the keyboard and receiver/device.
Multimedia keys not working	Software conflict; driver issue.	Ensure your operating system is up to date. Check for specific keyboard drivers if available from the manufacturer's website.
