This freestanding tall cabinet features two tempered glass doors on the upper section and two solid doors on the lower section, offering ample space for organizing a wide range of items. The design incorporates an adjustable shelf in the lower cabinet for flexible storage, along with fixed compartments in the upper section. Constructed from durable MDF, this cabinet is built for stability and long-lasting use, and includes an anti-toppling device for enhanced safety.

4. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly. Ensure all parts are present and accounted for. It is recommended to assemble the cabinet on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.

1. **Unpack and Identify Parts:** Carefully unpack all components from the box. Lay them out and identify each part using the provided hardware list and diagrams. Verify that all screws, dowels, and panels are present.
2. **Assemble the Base:** Attach the side panels to the bottom panel using the designated hardware. Ensure all connections are secure and flush.
3. **Install Back Panel:** Slide or attach the back panel into the grooves or designated areas on the assembled base and side panels. Secure with small nails or screws as indicated.
4. **Assemble Internal Shelves:** Insert the fixed shelves into their designated slots. For the adjustable shelf in the lower cabinet, insert the shelf pins into the desired height positions before placing the shelf.
5. **Attach Top Panel:** Secure the top panel to the assembled frame using the appropriate screws.
6. **Install Doors:** Attach the hinges to the cabinet doors and then to the cabinet frame. Ensure the doors are aligned properly and swing freely. Install the knobs onto the doors.
7. **Install Anti-Toppling Device:** For safety, securely attach the anti-toppling device to the top rear of the cabinet and then to a wall stud using the provided hardware. This prevents the cabinet from tipping over.

5. USAGE AND OPERATION

The upper cabinet with tempered glass doors is ideal for displaying items or storing smaller, organized goods. The lower cabinet, with its adjustable shelf, provides flexible storage for larger or varied items. Always distribute weight evenly across shelves to maintain stability.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

To ensure the longevity and appearance of your Giantex Storage Cabinet, follow these simple maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** The painted surface is smooth and anti-scratch. Wipe clean with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as these may damage the finish.
- **Spills:** Promptly wipe up any spills to prevent moisture damage to the engineered wood.
- **Weight Distribution:** Do not exceed the maximum weight capacities for the top panel (66 lbs) and individual shelves (22 lbs). Distribute weight evenly to prevent warping or instability.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically check all screws and fittings to ensure they remain tight. Tighten if necessary to maintain structural integrity.
- **Sunlight Exposure:** Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight, which can cause fading or discoloration of the finish.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Giantex Storage Cabinet, please refer to the following common troubleshooting tips:

- **Cabinet is Wobbly:**

- Ensure all screws and connections are fully tightened.
- Verify that the cabinet is placed on a flat, level surface.
- Confirm the anti-toppling device is properly installed and secured to the wall.

- **Doors Do Not Close Properly or Are Misaligned:**

- Check that the hinges are correctly installed and tightened. Adjust hinge screws if necessary to align the doors.
- Ensure the magnetic door stoppers are properly positioned and functional.
- Verify that no internal items are obstructing the door's closure.

- **Missing Parts:**

- Carefully re-check all packaging materials to ensure no small parts were overlooked.
- If a part is genuinely missing, please contact Giantex customer support with your model number and the specific part number required.

8. SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: To prevent tipping over, ensure the anti-toppling device is securely attached to the wall. Do not exceed the weight capacity of 66 lbs on the top panel and 22 lbs on each shelf. Keep children away from the cabinet to avoid pinch hazards.
