SETUP

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Wheels do not spin freely.	Debris caught in axle, bent axle, or manufacturing defect.	Carefully check for and remove any visible debris. If the axle appears bent, gentle straightening may be possible, but excessive force can cause breakage. If the issue persists and is not due to debris or damage from play, it may be a manufacturing defect.
Paint chipping or fading.	Rough handling, exposure to harsh elements (sunlight, chemicals), or normal wear and tear.	This is often a result of normal play or environmental factors. Ensure proper storage and gentle handling to minimize further damage. Paint touch-ups are generally not recommended as they can devalue collector's items.
