1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of your Nothing Phone (2). Please read this guide thoroughly before operating your device to ensure optimal performance and longevity. The Nothing Phone (2) features a unique Glyph Interface, Nothing OS 2.0, a powerful dual camera system, and an efficient LTPO OLED display.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items are present in your product packaging:

- Nothing Phone (2)
- · SIM Tray Ejector
- USB Cable
- · Screen Protector (pre-applied or included separately)

3. SETUP

3.1. SIM Card Installation

- 1. Locate the SIM card tray on the side of your Nothing Phone (2).
- 2. Insert the provided SIM tray ejector tool into the small hole next to the tray. Press firmly until the tray pops out.
- 3. Place your Nano-SIM card(s) into the tray with the gold contacts facing down. Ensure proper orientation.
- 4. Gently push the SIM tray back into the phone until it clicks into place.

3.2. Initial Power On and Configuration

- 1. Press and hold the Power button on the side of the device until the Nothing logo appears.
- 2. Follow the on-screen prompts to select your language, connect to a Wi-Fi network, and set up your Google account.
- 3. You may be prompted to transfer data from an old device. Follow the instructions if desired.

3.3. Charging the Device

Before first use, it is recommended to fully charge your Nothing Phone (2).

- Connect the USB cable to the charging port on the bottom of the phone and to a compatible power adapter.
- The device supports 15W Qi wireless charging. Place the phone on a compatible wireless charging pad for convenient charging.

4. OPERATING YOUR DEVICE

4.1. Glyph Interface

The Glyph Interface on the back of the Nothing Phone (2) provides a new way to interact with your device. It uses customizable light and sound sequences for various functions:

- Notifications: Assign unique light patterns for specific contacts or app notifications.
- Progress Indicator: Track timers, charging status, or delivery progress visually.
- **Ringtones:** Create personalized ringtones with corresponding Glyph light patterns using the Glyph Composer.

4.2. Nothing OS 2.0

Nothing OS 2.0 offers a distinct visual identity and enhanced customization options:

- Customization: Personalize app labels, grid design, widget sizes, and color themes.
- **Widgets:** Utilize new folder layouts and add key widgets directly to your lock screen for quick access to functions.

4.3. Camera System

The Nothing Phone (2) is equipped with an advanced camera system for high-quality photography and videography:

- **Rear Cameras:** Dual 50 MP main sensor and 50 MP ultra-wide sensor. Features include Advanced HDR, Motion Capture 2.0 (Al-powered subject detection), Night Mode, and 2x Super-Res Zoom.
- Front Camera: 32 MP sensor for clear portraits.
- Video Recording: Capture 4K video at 60fps with the main rear camera. The front camera supports 1080P video at 60fps. Action Mode with dual stabilization provides smooth results for dynamic scenes.






Image: A detailed close-up of the dual camera module on the back of the Nothing Phone (2), showing the two large lenses and flash.

4.4. Display

Experience vibrant visuals on the 6.7-inch LTPO OLED display:

- Brightness: Up to 1600 nit peak pixel brightness for clear visibility in various lighting conditions.
- Adaptive Refresh Rate: The LTPO technology allows the display to intuitively adapt its refresh rate up to 120 Hz, optimizing power consumption.
- Durability: Protected by Gorilla Glass 5 on both the front and back.

4.5. Battery and Charging

The Nothing Phone (2) is equipped with a long-lasting battery and versatile charging options:

- Capacity: 4700 mAh battery.
- Fast Charging: Achieve a full charge in approximately 55 minutes.
- Wireless Charging: Compatible with 15W Qi wireless charging.
- Reverse Wireless Charging: Functions as a 5W wireless charger to power accessories like earbuds.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1. Battery Care

- Avoid exposing the device to extreme temperatures (below 0°C or above 35°C) as this can degrade battery performance.
- For optimal battery health, avoid frequently discharging the battery completely or keeping it at 100% for extended periods.

5.2. Water Resistance (IP54)

The Nothing Phone (2) has an IP54 rating, meaning it is resistant to dust and splashes of water. This is not full waterproofing. To maintain water resistance:

- · Do not immerse the device in water.
- · Avoid exposing it to pressurized water or high-velocity water.
- Ensure the SIM tray is fully closed and sealed.
- Water resistance may decrease over time with normal wear and tear.

5.3. Cleaning

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the device.
- Avoid using abrasive materials, alcohol, or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the finish.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

6.1. Device Not Powering On

- Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the device to a charger for at least 15 minutes before attempting to power it on again.
- Press and hold the Power button for 10-15 seconds to perform a forced restart.

6.2. Charging Issues

- Verify that the USB cable and power adapter are functioning correctly. Try a different cable or adapter.
- Check the charging port for any debris or damage.

6.3. Network Connectivity Problems

- Ensure your SIM card is correctly inserted and activated.
- Check your device's network settings to confirm mobile data is enabled.
- · Restart the device.

6.4. Factory Reset

If you encounter persistent software issues, a factory reset may resolve them. **Warning:** This will erase all data on your device. Back up important data before proceeding. Consult the device settings for the factory reset option.
