# **HP TPN-Q221 14-inch Portable Laptop User Manual**

Model: TPN-Q221

## 1. OVERVIEW

The HP TPN-Q221 is a portable 14-inch laptop designed for general use, including student and business applications. It features an Intel Quad-Core N4120 processor, 16GB DDR4 RAM, and 64GB eMMC storage, running on Windows 11 Home. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your device.

## 2. SETUP

- 1. **Unboxing:** Carefully remove the laptop and all accessories from the packaging. Ensure all components listed in the "What's in the Box" section are present.
- 2. **Initial Charge:** Connect the power adapter to the laptop's power port and then to an electrical outlet. Allow the laptop to charge for at least 30 minutes before first use, or until the battery indicator shows a sufficient charge.
- 3. **Power On:** Open the laptop lid and press the power button, usually located on the top right of the keyboard.
- 4. **Windows 11 Setup:** Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the Windows 11 Home setup process. This includes selecting your region, connecting to a Wi-Fi network, creating a user account, and accepting the license agreement.
- 5. **Software Activation:** If applicable, activate the included 1-Year Office 365 subscription by following the prompts during Windows setup or by launching any Office application.

## 3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

## 3.1 Basic Navigation

• **Touchpad:** Use the integrated touchpad for cursor control. Tap to click, use two fingers to scroll, and pinch to zoom.

- **Keyboard:** The full-size keyboard allows for comfortable typing. Function keys (F1-F12) provide quick access to system settings like volume, brightness, and Wi-Fi.
- Windows Start Menu: Click the Windows icon on the taskbar to access applications, settings, and power options.

## 3.2 Connecting to Wi-Fi

- 1. Click the Wi-Fi icon in the taskbar.
- 2. Select your desired network from the list.
- 3. Enter the network security key (password) if prompted.
- 4. Click Connect.

## 3.3 Using the Webcam

The integrated webcam is suitable for video calls and online meetings. To use it, open an application that supports webcam functionality (e.g., Microsoft Teams, Zoom, Camera app).

#### 3.4 SD Card Reader

Insert an SD card into the dedicated SD card reader slot to access photos, videos, and other files. The card will appear as a removable drive in File Explorer.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning: Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and exterior. For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen cleaner. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- **Software Updates:** Regularly check for and install Windows updates to ensure optimal performance and security. Go to **Settings > Windows Update**.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Store the laptop in a cool, dry place when not in use for extended periods.
- **Storage Management:** Periodically review your stored files and uninstall unused applications to free up storage space and maintain system speed.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

## • Laptop Not Powering On:

- Ensure the power adapter is securely connected to both the laptop and a working electrical outlet.
- Verify the power outlet is functional by plugging in another device.
- If the battery is completely drained, allow it to charge for a few minutes before attempting to power on again.

## • Slow Performance:

- Close unnecessary applications running in the background.
- · Check for available Windows updates and install them.

- Run a disk cleanup or defragmentation tool (for HDD, not eMMC) to optimize storage.
- · Consider uninstalling programs you no longer use.

## • Wi-Fi Connectivity Issues:

- Restart your Wi-Fi router and modem.
- Ensure Wi-Fi is enabled on your laptop (check the Wi-Fi icon in the taskbar).
- Forget the network and reconnect, re-entering the password.
