

#### **Charging the Tablet**

Before first use, fully charge the tablet. Connect the USB Type-C cable to the tablet's charging port and the power adapter to a wall outlet. The battery indicator on the screen will show charging status.

Access the Settings menu, then navigate to 'Network & internet' for Wi-Fi or 'Connected devices' for Bluetooth. Select the desired network or device and follow the on-screen prompts to connect.

#### **Installing and Managing Apps**

The tablet comes with Google Play pre-installed. Open the Google Play Store app to browse and download a wide variety of applications. To manage installed apps, go to Settings > Apps. You can uninstall, disable, or clear data for individual applications.

## **Troubleshooting Common Issues**

Problem	Solution
Tablet does not turn on	Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the tablet to the charger for at least 30 minutes. If it still doesn't turn on, try a hard reset by pressing and holding the power button for 10-15 seconds.
Wi-Fi connection issues	Check if Wi-Fi is enabled in settings. Restart your Wi-Fi router. Forget the network and reconnect. Ensure you are within range of the Wi-Fi signal.
Apps crashing or slow performance	Close unused apps. Clear the cache of problematic apps (Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage > Clear cache). Ensure sufficient storage space is available. Restart the tablet.
Screen is unresponsive	Restart the tablet. If the issue persists, perform a factory reset (this will erase all data, so back up important files first).
Cannot connect to Bluetooth device	Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on both devices. Make sure the device is in pairing mode. Forget and re-pair the device.
