1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The TUINYO WH-960 are over-ear wireless headphones designed for an immersive audio experience. They feature Active Noise Cancellation (ANC), Bluetooth connectivity, and a long battery life, making them suitable for various environments including travel, home, and office use.

2. SETUP

2.1 What's in the Box

Upon unboxing, verify that all components are present:

2.2 Charging the Headphones

Before first use, fully charge the headphones. Connect the provided USB-C charging cable to the headphone's charging port and the other end to a USB power source (e.g., wall adapter, computer USB port). The LED indicator will show charging status.

- A full charge provides approximately 60 hours of playtime.
- Fast charging allows for 5 hours of playtime with just 10 minutes of charge.

2.3 Bluetooth Pairing

- 1. Ensure the headphones are powered off.
- 2. Press and hold the Power button until the LED indicator flashes blue and red, indicating pairing mode.
- 3. On your device (smartphone, tablet, computer), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
- 4. Select "TUINYO WH-960" from the list of devices.
- 5. Once connected, the LED indicator will show a solid blue light or flash blue slowly.

2.4 Adjusting for Fit

For optimal sound and comfort, adjust the headband and earcups:

- Extend or retract the headband to fit your head comfortably.
- The earcups are designed with multi-angle rotation and memory foam cushions for a secure and comfortable seal around your ears.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Power On/Off

- Power On: Press and hold the Power button for 2-3 seconds.
- Power Off: Press and hold the Power button for 3-4 seconds.

3.2 Volume and Playback Control

The control buttons are located on the earcup.

- Volume Up: Press the '+' button.
- Volume Down: Press the '-' button.
- Play/Pause: Press the Multi-function button (usually the power button or a dedicated play/pause button).
- Next Track: Press and hold the '+' button.
- Previous Track: Press and hold the '-' button.


3.3 Active Noise Cancellation (ANC)

The ANC feature reduces external low-frequency noise, providing a quieter listening environment.

- Activate ANC: Press the dedicated ANC button (if available) or refer to the specific button on your model. The ANC indicator light will illuminate.
- Deactivate ANC: Press the ANC button again.

3.4 Call Management

- Answer/End Call: Press the Multi-function button once.
- Reject Call: Press and hold the Multi-function button for 2 seconds.
- Redial Last Number: Double-press the Multi-function button.

3.5 Voice Assistant

Activate your device's voice assistant (Siri, Google Assistant, etc.) directly from the headphones.

• Activate Voice Assistant: Triple-press the Multi-function button.




Image 3.3: Support for voice assistant and clear hands-free calls.

3.6 Game Mode (Low Latency)

For an optimized gaming experience with reduced audio delay.

• Activate Game Mode: Refer to your specific model's instructions for activating low latency mode, typically a dedicated button or a combination press.

3.7 Wired Mode

The headphones can be used in wired mode with the included 3.5mm audio cable, even if the battery is depleted.

- Connect one end of the 3.5mm audio cable to the headphone's audio jack and the other end to your audio source.
- In wired mode, Bluetooth and ANC functions may be disabled or operate differently depending on the model.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Cleaning

- Wipe the headphones with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, alcohol, or chemical solvents.
- · Avoid getting moisture into any openings.

4.2 Storage

When not in use, store the headphones in their protective carrying case.

4.3 Battery Care

- Avoid fully discharging the battery frequently.
- Charge the headphones regularly, even if not used for extended periods, to maintain battery health.
- Store in a cool, dry place away from extreme temperatures.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

5.1 No Power

- Ensure the headphones are charged. Connect to a power source and check the charging indicator.
- Try a different charging cable and power adapter.

5.2 Cannot Pair via Bluetooth

- Ensure the headphones are in pairing mode (LED flashing blue and red).
- Turn off and on Bluetooth on your device.
- Move the headphones closer to your device.
- Clear previous Bluetooth connections on your device and try pairing again.
- Ensure no other Bluetooth devices are interfering.

5.3 No Sound or Low Volume

- Check the volume levels on both the headphones and your connected device.
- Ensure the headphones are properly paired and connected.
- If using wired mode, ensure the 3.5mm cable is fully inserted into both the headphones and the audio source.
- Test with a different audio source or device.

5.4 Active Noise Cancellation Not Working Effectively

- Ensure ANC is activated (check the indicator light).
- Ensure the earcups form a good seal around your ears. Adjust the fit if necessary.
- ANC is most effective against low-frequency, constant noise, not sudden or high-frequency sounds.

5.5 Headphones Disconnecting Frequently

- Ensure the headphones are within the Bluetooth range of your device.
- Avoid obstacles between the headphones and your device.
- · Check for interference from other wireless devices.
