2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

2.1 Key Features

- **Durable Construction:** Made from high-quality ABS plastic for excellent wear resistance and extended service life.
- **Flexible Programmability:** Features an LCD screen for intuitive control, allowing users to set the time, working period, and spray frequency.
- **Versatile Installation:** Supports both wall-mounted and desktop placement.
- **Long-Lasting Battery Power:** Operates on two D-size batteries (not included) for prolonged use.
- **Compatible Refills:** Designed for international standard size air freshener refills (10 fl.oz/300 ml, 5.51" H x 2.56" D).

2.2 Components

The AIKE AK1801 dispenser consists of the main unit with an integrated LCD screen, a spray nozzle, and a compartment for batteries and the air freshener refill can. Mounting hardware for wall installation is typically included.

3. SETUP

3.1 Battery Installation

1. Open the dispenser cover. This usually involves pressing a release button or using a key (if provided) to unlock the front panel.
2. Locate the battery compartment.
3. Insert two D-size batteries (not included) according to the polarity markings (+/-) inside the compartment.
4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

3.2 Air Freshener Canister Insertion

1. Ensure the dispenser is powered off or in a safe mode to prevent accidental sprays.
2. Open the dispenser cover.
3. Insert a compatible air freshener refill can into the designated slot. The dispenser is designed for international standard size refills, typically 10 fl.oz/300 ml, measuring 5.51" (H) x 2.56" (D).
4. Ensure the nozzle of the refill can is correctly aligned with the dispenser's spray mechanism.
5. Close the dispenser cover securely.

3.3 Mounting Options

The AIKE AK1801 offers two primary installation methods:

- **Wall-Mounted:** For optimal fragrance dispersion, mount the dispenser on a wall at a recommended height of 7 to 9 feet (approximately 2.1 to 2.7 meters) above the floor. Use the provided mounting hardware (screws and anchors) to secure the unit firmly.
- **Desktop Placement:** The dispenser can also be conveniently placed on a flat surface such as a desk or countertop for easy setup and use.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The LCD screen and control buttons allow for flexible programming of the dispenser's operation.

4.1 Setting the Current Time

1. Press the **MODE** button until 'CLOCK' or 'TIME' appears on the LCD.
2. Use the **UP/DOWN** buttons to adjust the hour.
3. Press **SET** to confirm the hour and move to minutes.
4. Use the **UP/DOWN** buttons to adjust the minutes.
5. Press **SET** to save the current time.

4.2 Programming Spray Interval

1. Press the **MODE** button until 'INTERVAL' or 'SPRAY' appears.
2. Use the **UP/DOWN** buttons to select the desired spray interval (e.g., 5, 10, 15, 30 minutes).
3. Press **SET** to confirm the interval.

4.3 Setting Working Period (Start/Stop Time)

1. Press the **MODE** button until 'START' or 'ON TIME' appears.
2. Use the **UP/DOWN** buttons to set the desired start hour for spraying.
3. Press **SET** to confirm and move to minutes (if applicable).
4. Repeat for 'STOP' or 'OFF TIME' to set the end hour for spraying.
5. Press **SET** to save the working period.

4.4 Day Selection (if available)

Some models allow selection of specific days for operation. If your model supports this:

1. Press the **MODE** button until 'DAY' or 'WEEK' appears.
2. Use the **UP/DOWN** buttons to select individual days or a range (e.g., Mon-Fri, Sat-Sun, Mon-Sun).
3. Press **SET** to confirm.

4.5 Test Spray

After setting up, a test spray function may be available. Press the **TEST** button (if present) to verify the spray mechanism is working correctly. Be aware of the spray direction.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning

Regular cleaning helps maintain the dispenser's appearance and functionality.

- Turn off the dispenser and remove the air freshener can.
- Wipe the exterior with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Ensure no liquid enters the battery compartment or electronic components.
- Clean the spray nozzle area gently to prevent blockages.

5.2 Air Freshener Canister Replacement

Replace the air freshener can when it is empty. Follow the steps outlined in Section 3.2 for insertion.

5.3 Battery Replacement

Replace the D-size batteries when the low battery indicator appears on the LCD screen or when the dispenser stops spraying. Follow the steps outlined in Section 3.1 for installation.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your AIKE AK1801 dispenser, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Dispenser not spraying	Empty air freshener can Dead batteries Incorrect programming Nozzle blockage	Replace air freshener can Replace batteries Check programming settings (time, interval, working period) Clean the spray nozzle
LCD screen is blank or dim	Dead or low batteries Incorrect battery insertion	Replace batteries Check battery polarity (+/-)

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Spray is weak or inconsistent	Low air freshener level Partially blocked nozzle Weak batteries	Replace air freshener can Clean the spray nozzle Replace batteries
Dispenser sprays at wrong times	Incorrect time setting Incorrect working period setting	Adjust current time (Section 4.1) Adjust working period (Section 4.3)


