Lorelli Myla Pushchair Instruction Manual

1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read this instruction manual carefully before assembling and using the Lorelli Myla Pushchair. Keep this manual for future reference.

- **WARNING:** Never leave your child unattended in the pushchair.
- **WARNING:** Ensure all locking devices are engaged before use.
- **WARNING:** Always use the restraint system.
- **WARNING:** Check that the pushchair body or seat unit attachment devices are correctly engaged before use.
- **WARNING:** This pushchair is suitable for children from 0 months up to a maximum weight of 15 kg.
- **WARNING:** Any load attached to the handle affects the stability of the pushchair.
- **WARNING:** The pushchair is not suitable for running or skating.
- Use only Lorelli approved replacement parts and accessories.
- Do not overload the storage basket. Maximum load for the basket is 2 kg.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Lorelli Myla Pushchair is designed for convenience and comfort, featuring a lightweight aluminum frame and a compact folding mechanism.

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

3.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Check for any damage or missing parts. Retain packaging for future transport or storage.

3.2 Unfolding the Pushchair

1. Place the pushchair on a flat surface.
2. Release the folding lock (if engaged).
3. Lift the handle firmly until the frame locks into the open position. Ensure both side locks are securely engaged.

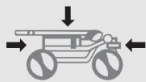
3.3 Attaching Wheels

Insert the front and rear wheels into their respective slots until they click into place. Pull on the wheels to ensure they are securely attached.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Folding the Pushchair (One-Hand System)

1. Ensure the child is removed from the pushchair.
2. Engage the rear wheel brakes.
3. Locate the one-hand folding mechanism on the handle.
4. Activate the mechanism and push the handle forward and down until the pushchair folds compactly.
5. Secure the folding lock.

4.2 Adjusting Backrest and Footrest

1. **Backrest:** Locate the adjustment strap or lever behind the seat. Recline or raise the backrest to the desired position.
2. **Footrest:** Press the buttons on either side of the footrest to adjust its angle for your child's comfort.

4.3 Using the 5-Point Safety Harness

1. Place your child in the seat.
2. Bring the shoulder straps over your child's shoulders and the waist straps around their waist.
3. Insert the two buckle prongs into the central buckle until they click securely.
4. Adjust the straps to ensure a snug, but not tight, fit. To release, press the button on the central buckle.



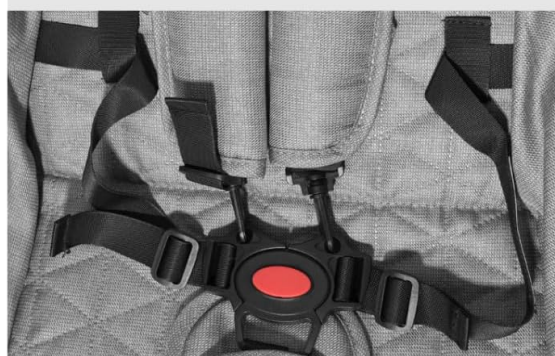

4.4 Brake Operation

To engage the rear wheel brakes, press down firmly on the brake lever located near the rear wheels until it locks. To release, lift the lever upwards. Always ensure the brakes are fully engaged when the pushchair is stationary.

4.5 Swivel Front Wheels

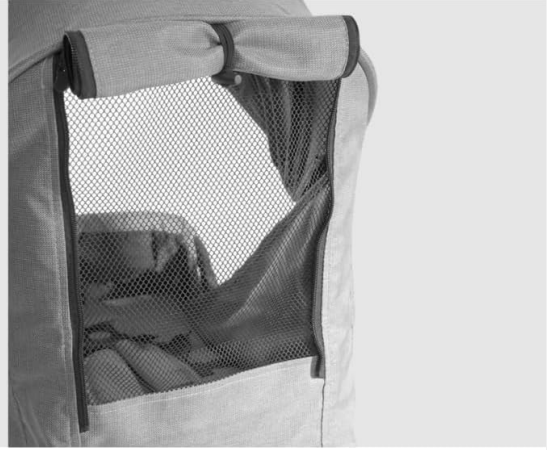
The front wheels can swivel for easy maneuverability. To lock them in a straight position for rougher terrain, push down the locking mechanism above each front wheel. Lift the mechanism to unlock for swiveling.

4.6 Canopy and Ventilation

The adjustable canopy provides shade and protection. It features a net-like window for ventilation, which can be opened or closed as needed to ensure optimal airflow for your child.

4.7 Removable Front Bar

The front bar can be removed for easier access when placing or removing your child. Press the release buttons on either side of the bar and pull it away from the frame.

4.8 Footcover and Mosquito Net

The pushchair includes a footcover for warmth and a mosquito net for protection against insects. Attach these accessories as needed using the designated fasteners on the pushchair frame.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning

- Wipe clean the fabric parts with a damp cloth and mild soap. Do not use harsh detergents or bleach.
- The frame can be cleaned with a damp cloth. Dry thoroughly after cleaning.
- Regularly clean the wheels to remove dirt and debris that may affect their movement.

5.2 Storage

When not in use, store the pushchair in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight. Ensure it is clean and

dry before storing to prevent mold or mildew.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Difficulty Folding/Unfolding:** Ensure all locks are disengaged before unfolding and that the seat is in an upright position before folding. Check for any obstructions in the folding mechanism.
- **Wheels Not Turning Smoothly:** Clean any dirt or debris from the wheel axles. Apply a small amount of silicone-based lubricant if necessary. Ensure the swivel locks are disengaged if you want the wheels to swivel.
- **Harness Not Securing:** Check that the buckle prongs are fully inserted into the central buckle until a click is heard. Adjust straps for a snug fit.
