# LEKATO AM-718 Bluetooth Speaker Metronome Instruction Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

The LEKATO AM-718 is a versatile 2-in-1 device combining a digital metronome with a portable Bluetooth speaker. Designed for musicians, it offers precise tempo guidance, vocal counting, and audio playback capabilities, making it suitable for practicing various musical instruments.

## 2. PRODUCT FEATURES

- **Bluetooth Integration:** Connects via Bluetooth 5.0 for beat sounds and music playback with a 10-meter range and low latency.
- **Versatile Functionality:** Features vocal counts, powerful sound output, and a clear LED tempo indicator. Includes a 3.5mm earphone jack for private practice.
- **Essential Rhythm Tool:** Offers a tempo range of 30 to 260 beats per minute, 10 beat options (0-9), and 8 rhythm patterns to support diverse musical genres.
- **Portable Design:** Compact and durable, allowing for easy transport and use as a portable Bluetooth speaker when the metronome function is disengaged.
- **Rechargeable Battery:** Built-in lithium battery provides approximately 10 hours of playtime on a 2-hour charge. Includes a USB Type-C cable for convenient charging.

#### 4. DEVICE LAYOUT AND CONTROLS

- **Display Screen:** Shows current beat, tempo, rhythm pattern, and battery status.

- **Tempo Knob:** Rotates to adjust the beats per minute (BPM).
- **BT Button:** Activates Bluetooth pairing mode.
- **VOICE Button:** Toggles vocal counting on/off.
- **BEAT Button:** Cycles through different beat counts (0-9).
- **RHY Button:** Cycles through different rhythm patterns.
- **Power Button:** Turns the device on/off.
- **Volume Slider:** Adjusts the overall sound output volume.
- **Headphone Jack (3.5mm):** For private listening.
- **USB 5V (Type-C) Port:** For charging the device.

## 5. SETUP

---

### 5.1 Charging the Device

1. Connect the provided USB Type-C cable to the USB 5V port on the side of the metronome.
2. Plug the other end of the USB cable into a compatible USB power adapter (not included) or a computer's USB port.
3. The battery indicator on the display will show charging status. A full charge typically takes 2 hours.

### 5.2 Powering On/Off

- Press and hold the Power button for 2 seconds to turn the device on or off.

## 6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 6.1 Metronome Function

1. **Adjusting Tempo:** Rotate the Tempo knob clockwise to increase BPM or counter-clockwise to decrease BPM (range: 30-260 BPM).
2. **Changing Beat:** Press the BEAT button to cycle through different beat counts (0, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9).
3. **Selecting Rhythm:** Press the RHY button to choose from 8 different rhythm patterns.
4. **Vocal Counting:** Press the VOICE button to toggle vocal counting (e.g., "one, two, three, four") on or off.
5. **Start/Pause:** Press the Power button briefly to start or pause the metronome.

## 6.2 Bluetooth Speaker Function

1. **Pairing:** Turn on Bluetooth on your phone or instrument. Search for the device named "AM-718" and pair.
2. **Audio Playback:** Once paired, you can play music or backing tracks through the metronome's speaker.
3. **Mixing Audio:** The device can mix metronome beats with Bluetooth audio.
4. **Standalone Speaker:** To use solely as a Bluetooth speaker, turn off the metronome beat sound.

## 6.3 Headphone Use

- Plug 3.5mm headphones into the headphone jack for private practice sessions.

## 7. MAINTENANCE

- Keep the device dry and away from extreme temperatures.
- Clean with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- Store in a safe place to prevent physical damage.

## 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **No Sound:** Check volume level and ensure headphones are properly connected or Bluetooth is paired correctly.
- **Device Not Turning On:** Ensure the battery is charged. Connect to a power source using the USB-C cable.
- **Bluetooth Pairing Issues:** Ensure the device is in pairing mode and within the 10-meter range. Try restarting both the metronome and the Bluetooth source device.
