User Manual

INTRODUCTION

The LifeStraw Go 1-Liter (Grey) is an advanced water bottle equipped with a two-stage filter system designed to protect against bacteria, parasites, microplastics, and chemicals like chlorine, while also improving water taste. This leak-proof, BPA-free bottle is an ideal companion for hiking, camping, international travel, and emergency preparedness. Simply fill it with water from a lake, river, or tap, and filter on the go, eliminating the need for single-use plastic bottles.

LifeStraw filters are rigorously tested to meet regulations set by the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and NSF International/ANSI standards.

KEY FEATURES

- **Comprehensive Filtration:** Protects against 99.999999% of bacteria (including E. coli, Salmonella), 99.999% of parasites (including Giardia and Cryptosporidium), 99.999% of microplastics, chlorine, organic chemical matter, and turbidity. Significantly improves taste.
- **Capacity:** 1 Liter (approximately 34 fluid ounces).
- **Easy to Clean:** The bottle and cap are dishwasher-safe once the filter is removed.
- **Long-lasting Filters:** The durable membrane microfilter lasts up to 4,000 liters (1,000 gallons), and the activated carbon filter lasts up to 100 liters (26 gallons) with proper use and care.

TECHNOLOGY

1. Membrane microfilter

SETUP

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging: water bottle, water filter, cap with silicone mouthpiece, and carabiner.
2. **Initial Rinse:** Before first use, fill the bottle with clean water and perform a preliminary rinse by sipping water through the filter. Discard the first few sips.
3. **Assemble:** Ensure the membrane microfilter and activated carbon filter are securely inserted into the cap assembly. Twist the cap onto the bottle until it is tightly sealed.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Fill the Bottle:** Unscrew the cap and fill the bottle with water from your desired source (lake, river, tap, etc.). Do not fill above the maximum fill line.

2. **Secure the Cap:** Screw the cap back onto the bottle tightly to prevent leaks.
3. **Drink:** Open the silicone mouthpiece and sip directly from the straw. The water will be filtered as you drink.
4. **Storage During Use:** When not actively drinking, ensure the mouthpiece is closed to prevent spills. The carabiner can be used to attach the bottle to a backpack or gear.

MAINTENANCE

- Daily Cleaning:** After each use, unscrew the cap and remove the filter. Rinse the bottle and cap with clean water. The bottle and cap are dishwasher-safe once the filter is removed.
- Filter Backwash:** To ensure optimal flow rate and extend the life of the membrane microfilter, periodically backwash it. This is done by blowing air back through the mouthpiece.
- Activated Carbon Filter Replacement:** The activated carbon filter should be replaced after approximately 100 liters (26 gallons) of use, or every 3 months, whichever comes first, to maintain taste improvement and chemical reduction.
- Membrane Microfilter Lifespan:** The membrane microfilter will stop allowing water to pass through when it has reached the end of its lifespan (approximately 4,000 liters or 1,000 gallons). This is a safety feature, indicating it's time for replacement.
- Long-Term Storage:** For storage longer than 1 month, ensure the filter is completely dry. Follow specific instructions from LifeStraw for proper long-term storage to prevent mold or damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Difficulty drawing water / Slow flow rate	Filter clogged or nearing end of life. Airlock in filter.	Perform a backwash by blowing air through the mouthpiece. If flow does not improve, the filter may need replacement. Ensure the bottle is not completely full, allowing air to enter.
Water tastes bad or unusual	Activated carbon filter is exhausted.	Replace the activated carbon filter.
Leakage from bottle	Cap not screwed on tightly. Mouthpiece not fully closed. Damaged seal.	Ensure the cap is securely tightened. Close the mouthpiece completely after drinking. Inspect seals for damage and replace if necessary.
