IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always follow these basic safety precautions when using your radio:

- Do not expose the unit to rain, moisture, or extreme temperatures.
- Do not disassemble or modify the unit. Refer all servicing to qualified personnel.
- Ensure proper ventilation around the unit to prevent overheating.
- Use only the power adapter supplied with the unit.
- Keep the unit away from strong magnetic fields.
- Avoid listening at excessively high volumes for prolonged periods to prevent hearing damage.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the controls and display of your Spitalfields 2 radio.



The front panel features a clear display, speaker, and various control buttons.

Front Panel Controls

- **Display Screen:** Shows time, station information, and menu options.
- **Preset Buttons (1-6):** Store and recall your favorite stations.
- **PRESET Button:** Access preset memory.
- **SLEEP Button:** Set sleep timer.
- **SCAN Button:** Automatically scan for stations.
- **PLAY/PAUSE Button:** Play/pause in Bluetooth mode.
- **MENU Button:** Access system settings.
- **MODE Button:** Switch between DAB, FM, and Bluetooth modes.
- **EQ Button:** Adjust equalizer settings.
- **POWER Button:** Turn the unit on/off.
- **ENTER/VOLUME Knob:** Rotate to adjust volume or navigate menus; press to confirm selection.

- **SKIP Buttons** (<<, >>): Navigate tracks in Bluetooth mode or stations in radio mode.

SETUP

Powering On

1. Extend the telescopic antenna fully for optimal reception.
2. Connect the supplied power adapter to the DC IN port on the back of the radio and plug it into a wall outlet. The internal battery will begin charging.
3. Press the **POWER** button to turn on the radio.

Initial Scan (DAB/FM)

Upon first power-on, the radio will automatically perform a full scan for DAB stations. This may take a few minutes. Once complete, the radio will tune to the first available station.

- To manually initiate a scan in DAB mode, press the **SCAN** button.
- In FM mode, press and hold the **SCAN** button to auto-scan for the next available station.

Setting Time and Date

The time and date are usually automatically set via DAB signal. If not, or if you wish to adjust manually:

1. Press the **MENU** button.
2. Rotate the **ENTER/VOLUME** knob to navigate to 'System Settings' and press the knob to confirm.
3. Navigate to 'Time/Date' and press to confirm.
4. Select 'Set Time/Date' or 'Auto Update' as desired and follow the on-screen prompts.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Radio Modes (DAB, FM)

Press the **MODE** button to switch between DAB and FM radio modes.

DAB Mode

- Rotate the **ENTER/VOLUME** knob to browse available DAB stations. Press the knob to select a station.
- Press **SCAN** to perform a full scan for new stations.

FM Mode

- Rotate the **ENTER/VOLUME** knob to fine-tune the frequency.
- Press and hold the **SCAN** button to automatically tune to the next strong station.

Bluetooth Operation

1. Press the **MODE** button until 'Bluetooth' is displayed. The radio will enter pairing mode.
2. On your Bluetooth-enabled device (e.g., smartphone), search for 'Spitalfields 2' in the Bluetooth settings and select it to pair.
3. Once paired, you can stream audio from your device to the radio. Use the **PLAY/PAUSE** and **SKIP** buttons on the radio or remote to control playback.

Alarm Clock Function

1. Press the **MENU** button and navigate to 'Alarms'.
2. Select 'Alarm 1' or 'Alarm 2' to configure.
3. Set the alarm time, duration, source (Buzzer, DAB, FM), and frequency (Daily, Once, Weekdays, Weekends).
4. Ensure the alarm is set to 'On'.
5. When an alarm sounds, press the **POWER** button to snooze, or press any other button to turn off the alarm.

Sleep Timer

The sleep timer allows the radio to turn off automatically after a set period.

- Press the **SLEEP** button repeatedly to cycle through sleep timer options (e.g., 15, 30, 45, 60, 90, 120 minutes, Off).
- The selected time will be displayed briefly.

Presets

Storing a Preset

1. Tune to the desired DAB or FM station.
2. Press and hold one of the numbered **PRESET** buttons (1-6) until 'Preset Stored' appears on the display.

Recalling a Preset

- Briefly press the corresponding numbered **PRESET** button (1-6) to recall a stored station.

Audio Settings (EQ)

Adjust the sound profile to your preference.

- Press the **EQ** button repeatedly to cycle through equalizer presets (e.g., Normal, Flat, Jazz, Rock, Classical, Pop, News, My EQ).
- If 'My EQ' is selected, you can customize bass and treble settings via the menu.

Using the Remote Control

The remote control provides full functionality of the radio from a distance. Ensure the remote has working batteries and is pointed towards the front of the radio.

- All buttons on the remote correspond to functions available on the radio's front panel.
- Use the numeric buttons (0-9) to directly enter preset numbers or navigate menus.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the radio with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Battery Care:** For optimal battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. If storing the radio for an extended period, charge it fully every few months.
- **Antenna:** Handle the telescopic antenna with care to prevent damage.
- **Storage:** Store the radio in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power adapter not connected; battery depleted.	Ensure power adapter is securely connected and plugged in. Charge the battery.
No sound / Poor sound quality	Volume too low; poor signal; incorrect mode.	Increase volume. Extend antenna fully. Re-scan for stations. Ensure correct mode (DAB/FM/Bluetooth).
DAB stations not found	Weak DAB signal; no full scan performed.	Ensure antenna is fully extended. Perform a full DAB scan. Try repositioning the radio.
Bluetooth not pairing	Radio not in Bluetooth mode; device too far; previously paired.	Switch radio to Bluetooth mode. Ensure device is within range. Forget 'Spitalfields 2' on your device and try pairing again.
Remote control not working	Batteries depleted; obstruction; not pointed correctly.	Replace remote control batteries. Ensure no obstruction between remote and radio. Point remote directly at the radio's front panel.
