SETUP

Unpacking

Carefully remove the sewing machine from its packaging. Retain all packaging materials for future transport or storage. Ensure all included accessories are present.

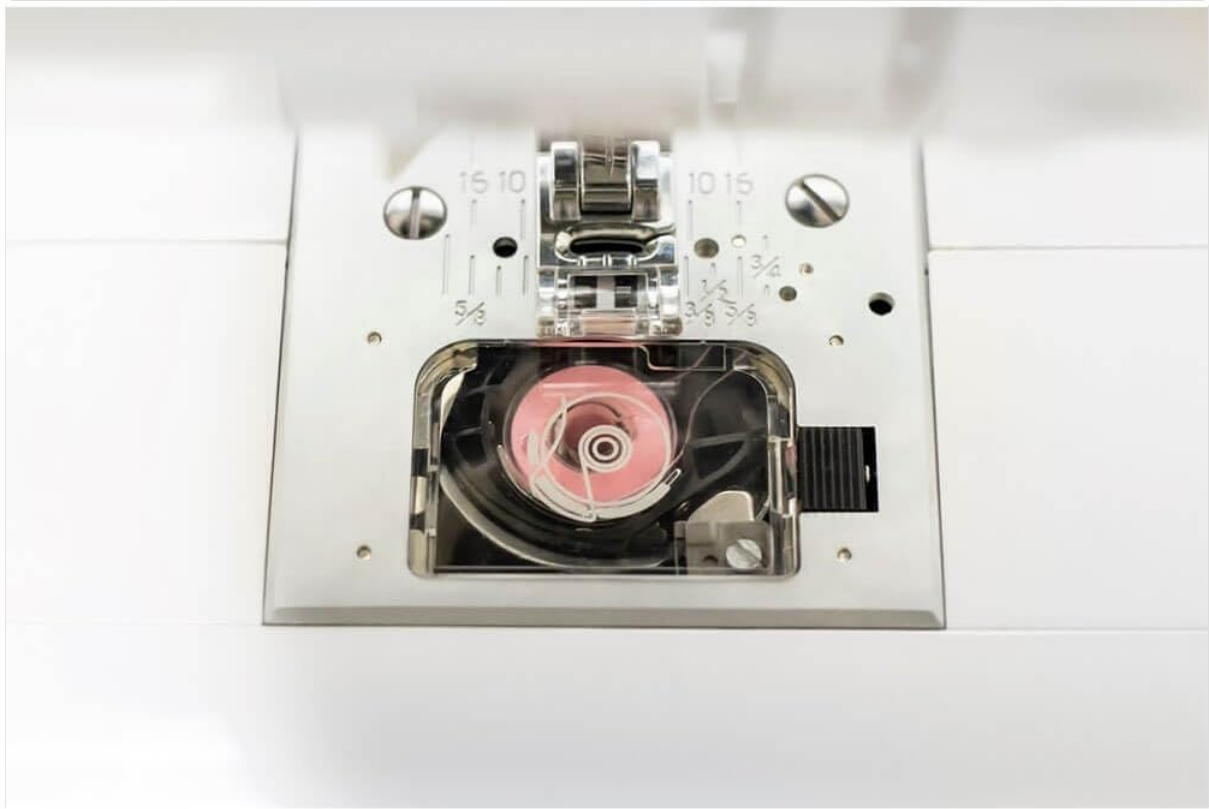
OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Threading the Machine

1. Place a spool of thread on the spool pin.
2. Follow the numbered threading path indicated on the machine.
3. Utilize the built-in needle threader for easy needle threading.

Winding the Bobbin

Refer to the machine's markings for correct bobbin winding. Ensure the thread is evenly wound for optimal stitch quality.

Stitch Selection

Use the control panel to select from the 200 available stitch applications. The machine offers various utility, decorative, and buttonhole stitches.

Starting to Sew

Place your fabric under the presser foot. Lower the presser foot lever. Gently press the foot controller or use the Start/Stop button to begin sewing. Adjust stitch length and width as needed.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

Regularly clean lint and dust from the bobbin area and feed dogs using the brush provided. Disconnect power before cleaning.

Needle Replacement

Replace the needle frequently, especially when working with new projects or if the needle becomes dull or bent. Use only SINGER-approved needles.

Lubrication

This machine is designed for minimal lubrication. Refer to the full manual for specific lubrication points if required, though typically not needed for general use.

TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

Skipped Stitches

- Ensure the needle is inserted correctly and is not bent.

- Check that the machine is properly threaded.
- Use the correct needle type and size for your fabric.

Thread Breaking

- Verify correct upper and bobbin tension.
- Check for burrs on the needle plate or bobbin case.
- Ensure the thread is not old or of poor quality.

Machine Jamming

- Remove any tangled thread from the bobbin area.
- Ensure the bobbin is correctly wound and inserted.
- Do not force the machine; turn it off and clear any obstructions.
