Generic Robot Vacuum Cleaner Spare Parts User Manual

For Proscenic 811GB, 911SE, Symbo xBot 5 PRO, and Lauben Robot Vacuum 26BB

INTRODUCTION

This user manual provides detailed instructions for the installation, maintenance, and replacement of Generic brand spare parts for various robot vacuum cleaner models. Regular replacement of these parts ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your robot vacuum.

COMPATIBLE MODELS

These spare parts are compatible with the following robot vacuum cleaner models:

- Proscenic 811GB
- Proscenic 911SE
- Symbo xBot 5 PRO
- Lauben Robot Vacuum 26BB

Please verify your robot vacuum model number before installation to ensure compatibility.

PACKAGE CONTENTS (SET G)

Your package (Set G) typically includes:

- Side Brushes (quantity may vary per set, refer to packaging)
- HEPA Filters (if included in your specific set)
- Mop Rags (if included in your specific set)
- Main Brush (if included in your specific set)

Please check your specific product packaging for the exact contents of "Set G".

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Always power off your robot vacuum cleaner and disconnect it from the charging base before performing any maintenance or part replacement.

1. Side Brush Installation

The side brushes help sweep debris from edges and corners into the vacuum's cleaning path.

1. Turn the robot vacuum cleaner upside down on a flat, stable surface.
2. Locate the existing side brushes. Depending on your model, they may be secured by a screw or simply snap into place.
3. If secured by a screw, use a screwdriver to remove the screw holding the old side brush. Carefully pull the old brush upwards to remove it.
4. Align the new side brush with the corresponding post on the vacuum. Ensure the brush arms are correctly oriented.
5. Press the new side brush firmly into place or secure it with the screw you removed earlier. Do not overtighten.

2. HEPA Filter Replacement

HEPA filters capture fine dust and allergens, improving air quality. Replace them regularly for best performance.

1. Open the dustbin compartment of your robot vacuum.
2. Remove the dustbin.
3. Locate the filter housing within the dustbin. Remove the old HEPA filter by pulling it out.
4. Insert the new HEPA filter into the housing, ensuring it is seated correctly.
5. Close the dustbin and reinsert it into the vacuum cleaner.

3. Mop Rag Attachment (for models with mopping function)

Mop rags are used for wet cleaning and should be replaced or cleaned after each use.

1. Locate the mop attachment or water tank on your robot vacuum.
2. Remove the used mop rag.
3. Attach the new mop rag to the designated area, ensuring it is securely fastened (e.g., via Velcro or clips).
4. Refill the water tank if necessary and reattach it to the vacuum.

4. Main Brush Replacement

The main brush is critical for picking up larger debris and should be inspected and cleaned regularly.

1. Turn the robot vacuum cleaner upside down.
2. Locate the main brush cover, usually secured by clips or screws.
3. Open or remove the main brush cover.
4. Lift out the old main brush. Clean any hair or debris tangled around the brush and its bearings.
5. Insert the new main brush, ensuring the ends fit into their respective slots.
6. Close or reattach the main brush cover securely.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Regular maintenance of your robot vacuum's spare parts is essential for its efficiency and longevity.

- **Side Brushes:** Inspect weekly for tangled hair or debris. Clean as needed. Replace every 3-6 months, or sooner if visibly worn or damaged.
- **HEPA Filters:** Tap clean weekly to remove loose dust. Do not wash. Replace every 1-3 months, depending on usage and pet presence.
- **Mop Rags:** Wash after each use. Replace every 1-3 months, or if they show signs of wear or reduced absorbency.
- **Main Brush:** Inspect weekly for tangled hair or debris. Use the cleaning tool (if provided with your vacuum) to remove tangles. Replace every 6-12 months, or if bristles are significantly worn.
- **Dustbin:** Empty after each cleaning cycle. Wash with water if necessary and allow to air dry completely before reinserting.

Note: Replacement frequency may vary based on usage, environment, and presence of pets.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues after replacing parts, consider the following:

- **Parts not fitting:** Double-check that you have purchased the correct spare parts for your specific robot vacuum model. Refer to the "Compatible Models" section.
- **Reduced cleaning performance:** Ensure all brushes are free of tangles and debris. Verify that the HEPA filter is clean and correctly installed. Check if the main brush is spinning freely.
- **Unusual noises:** Inspect all rotating parts (main brush, side brushes) for obstructions or incorrect installation. Ensure no foreign objects are caught in the vacuum's mechanisms.

If problems persist, consult your robot vacuum cleaner's original user manual or contact the manufacturer of your robot vacuum for further assistance.
