1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Winado 12V Licensed Mercedes Benz AMG GTR Ride-On Car. Please read it thoroughly before first use and retain it for future reference. This electric vehicle offers a realistic driving experience for children aged 3 to 5 years, featuring both manual and parental remote control operation.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Age Range:** Suitable for children aged 36 months to 5 years.
- **Maximum Weight Capacity:** Do not exceed 55 lbs (25 kg).
- **Adult Supervision:** Always ensure direct adult supervision during operation.
- **Seat Belt:** Always fasten the adjustable seat belt before operation.
- **Parental Remote Control:** For younger children or added safety, parents can control the vehicle using the included remote control.
- **Smooth Start:** The vehicle features a smooth start design to prevent sudden jolts.
- **Environment:** Use on flat, dry surfaces. Avoid slopes, uneven terrain, or public roads.
- **Battery Safety:** Keep batteries away from children. Do not mix old and new batteries.

3. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

- 1 x Winado 12V Licensed Mercedes Benz AMG GTR Electric Car
- 1 x 2.4G Remote Control
- 1 x Charger
- 1 x Instruction Manual (this document)

4. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly requires adult supervision. Follow these general steps. Refer to the detailed diagrams in the physical manual for specific part identification and attachment points.

1. **Prepare the Vehicle:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. **Connect the Battery:** Locate the battery compartment, typically under the seat or hood. Connect the battery terminals as indicated.
3. **Attach the Wheels:** Securely attach all four wheels to the axles using the provided hardware (washers, nuts, caps).
4. **Install the Steering Wheel:** Connect the steering column to the vehicle body and attach the steering wheel, ensuring all electrical connections for horn/music are made.
5. **Install the Seat:** Place the seat into its designated position and secure it with screws or clips.
6. **Final Checks:** Ensure all connections are secure and all screws are tightened.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Modes of Operation

- **Child Manual Operation:** The child can operate the vehicle using the steering wheel and foot pedal. This mode offers 2-speed adjustment.
- **Parental Remote Control:** Parents can control the direction and speed (3-speed adjustment) using the 2.4G remote control. This is ideal for younger children or when direct supervision is needed.

5.2. Key Features

- **Speed:** Maximum speed can reach 3 Mph. Features a smooth start function for gentle acceleration.
- **Lights:** Equipped with bright headlights and realistic taillights.
- **Entertainment System:** Built-in music, voltage display, USB and AUX connectors, volume control, and TF card slot with speakers.
- **Comfort & Safety:** Wider seat and adjustable seat belt for a safe and comfortable experience. Openable doors for easy entry and exit.

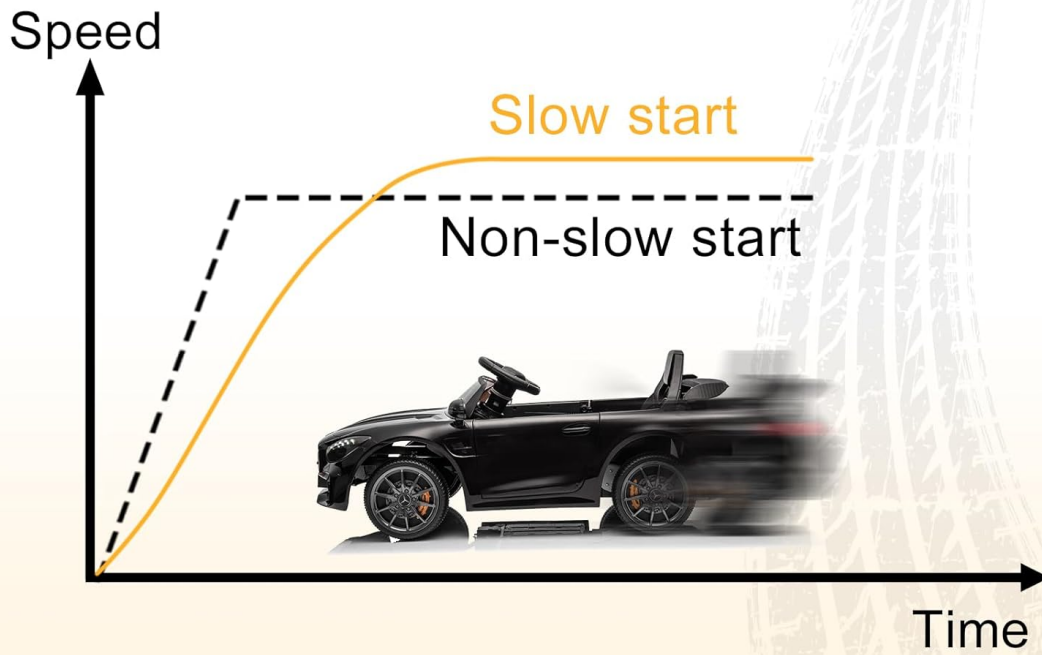


Figure 5: The 'Slow Start' function ensures a gentle acceleration for child safety.

6. CHARGING INSTRUCTIONS

- **Battery Type:** 12V rechargeable battery.
- **Charging Time:** The battery requires 8-12 hours for a full charge.
- **Run Time:** A fully charged battery can provide 1-2 hours of continuous operation, depending on usage and terrain.
- **First Use:** Charge the battery for a full 12 hours before the first use to ensure optimal battery life.
- **Charger:** Use only the charger provided with the vehicle.
- **Charging Location:** Charge in a dry, well-ventilated area, away from flammable materials.

7. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the vehicle with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the vehicle in a dry place when not in use. If storing for extended periods, ensure the battery is fully charged and disconnect it. Recharge the battery every 3 months to maintain its health.
- **Battery Care:** Do not overcharge the battery. Replace the battery when it no longer holds a charge.
- **Inspection:** Regularly check for loose screws, damaged parts, or worn tires. Replace any damaged components immediately.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vehicle does not move	Battery is low or disconnected; Power switch is off; Motor malfunction.	Charge battery; Check battery connections; Turn on power switch; Contact customer support.
Remote control not working	Remote batteries are dead; Remote not paired; Interference.	Replace AAA batteries in remote; Re-pair remote with vehicle (refer to pairing instructions in physical manual); Move to an area with less interference.
Short run time	Battery not fully charged; Old battery; Overloaded vehicle.	Charge battery for 8-12 hours; Replace battery if old; Ensure vehicle is not overloaded.
Vehicle makes unusual noises	Loose parts; Debris in wheels/motor.	Check and tighten all screws; Remove any debris from moving parts.

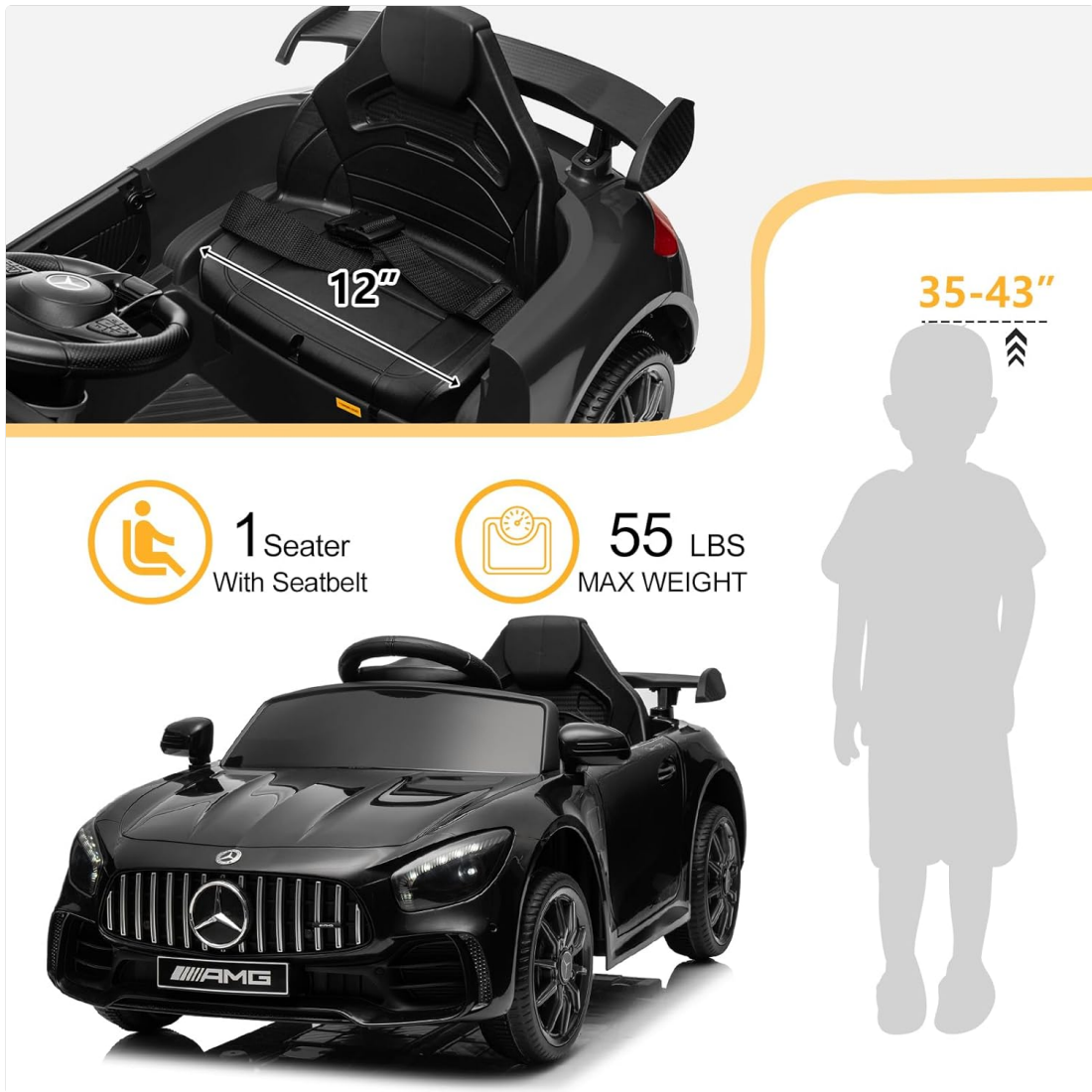


Figure 7: Size and weight recommendations for the ride-on car.

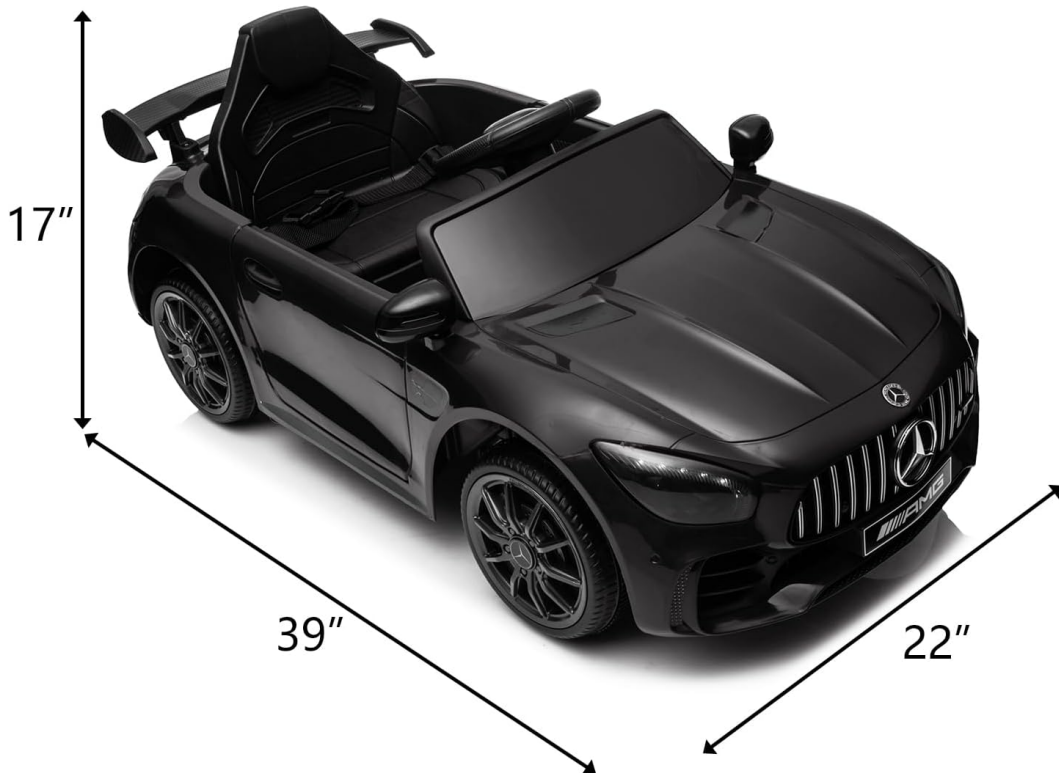


Figure 8: Detailed product dimensions of the vehicle.
