1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the Dell Precision 3561 Workstation Laptop. 2. SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your Dell Precision 3561 Workstation Laptop for the first time.

2.1 Unpacking and Initial Inspection

3.2 Using the Keyboard and Touchpad




Image: Keyboard and Touchpad

- Do not leave the battery fully discharged for extended periods.
- For optimal battery health, avoid constantly keeping the laptop plugged in at 100% charge. Dell Power Manager software can help manage battery charging behavior.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

5.1 General Troubleshooting Steps

- **Restart the Laptop:** Many issues can be resolved by simply restarting the system.
- **Check Connections:** Ensure all cables (power, peripherals) are securely connected.

5.2 Common Issues

- **Screen is blank:** Check if the laptop is in sleep mode. Press any key or the power button to wake it. Ensure external monitors are properly connected if used.
- **Slow performance:** Close unnecessary applications. Check for malware. Ensure sufficient free space on the SSD.
- **Wi-Fi or Bluetooth not working:** Check if Wi-Fi/Bluetooth is enabled in Windows settings. Restart the laptop. Update wireless drivers.
