ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


Assembling your Titanic model requires patience and attention to detail due to the micro size of the building blocks. Follow the included instruction guide for a smooth building experience.

illustrated to show block placement.



5. **Patience is Key:** This is a challenging build. Take breaks if needed and approach each section with care.

DISPLAY AND CARE

Once assembled, your Titanic model is a display piece. Proper care will ensure its longevity.

- **Display Surface:** Place the model on a stable, flat surface away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures to prevent discoloration or warping.
- **Cleaning:** Dust the model regularly with a soft, dry brush or a can of compressed air. Avoid using liquid cleaners, which may damage the plastic.
- **Handling:** Handle the model with care, especially when moving it, as small parts can detach if not handled gently.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter during or after assembly:

- **Missing Pieces:** If you believe a piece is missing, thoroughly check the packaging and surrounding area. Due to their small size, blocks can be easily overlooked. If still missing, contact customer support.
- **Blocks Not Fitting:** Ensure the blocks are correctly oriented and aligned. Apply gentle, even pressure. Avoid forcing blocks, as this can cause damage.
- **Model Instability:** Re-examine the connections in the affected area. Ensure all blocks are fully pressed together according to the instructions.




Image: The alltogetho Titanic model displaying its length (60cm / 23.6 inches) and height (16.5cm / 6.5 inches).
