# INOI A63 4G LTE Smartphone User Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient use of your INOI A63 4G LTE smartphone. Please read this guide thoroughly before operating your device to ensure optimal performance and longevity. The INOI A63 features a 6.5-inch HD+ IPS display, an Octa-core processor, dual cameras, and a 5000 mAh battery.

### 4. SETUP

#### 4.1. SIM Card and Memory Card Installation

1. Locate the SIM card tray on the side of your device.
2. Insert the SIM ejector tool into the small hole next to the tray and push gently until the tray pops out.
3. Place your Nano-SIM card(s) and/or microSD card (if desired) into the designated slots on the tray.

Ensure proper orientation.

4. Carefully reinsert the tray into the phone until it clicks into place.

## 4.2. Initial Power On

1. Press and hold the Power button (usually on the right side of the device) until the INOI logo appears on the screen.
2. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the initial setup, including language selection, Wi-Fi connection, and Google account setup.

## 5. OPERATING YOUR DEVICE

### 5.1. Display and Navigation

The INOI A63 features a 6.5-inch HD+ IPS LCD display with a resolution of 720 x 1600 pixels. Navigate your device using touch gestures: tap, swipe, pinch-to-zoom.

### 5.2. Camera Functions

Your INOI A63 is equipped with a dual camera system:

- **Rear Camera:** 13 MP main camera with f/2.2 aperture and autofocus.
- **Front Camera:** 8 MP for selfies and video calls.

Open the Camera app from your home screen or app drawer to capture photos and videos. Explore various modes and settings for optimal results.

### 5.3. Fingerprint Sensor

The INOI A63 includes a rear-mounted fingerprint sensor for secure and quick unlocking.

1. Go to *Settings > Security > Fingerprint*
2. Follow the on-screen instructions to register your fingerprint(s).
3. Once registered, you can unlock your phone by placing your finger on the sensor.

### 5.4. Memory Fusion



## 6. BATTERY MANAGEMENT

The INOI A63 is equipped with a 5,000 mAh Li-Ion battery, designed for extended usage.

## 6.1. Charging

Use the provided Type-C charger to charge your device. Connect the charger to the USB-C port on your phone and plug it into a power outlet. The battery indicator on the screen will show charging status.

## 6.2. Battery Saving Tips

- Reduce screen brightness.
- Turn off Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, and GPS when not in use.
- Close background applications.
- Enable battery saver mode in settings.

## 7. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of the phone. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- **Water Resistance:** This device is not water-resistant. Avoid exposure to liquids.
- **Temperature:** Operate the device within recommended temperature ranges (typically 0°C to 35°C).
- **Software Updates:** Regularly check for and install software updates to ensure optimal performance

and security.

## 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

### 8.1. Device Not Turning On

- Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the charger and wait a few minutes before attempting to power on.
- Press and hold the Power button for at least 10-15 seconds to perform a forced restart.

### 8.2. Poor Battery Life

- Review battery saving tips in Section 6.2.
- Check for apps consuming excessive battery in *Settings > Battery*.
- Ensure the device is running the latest software update.

### 8.3. Network Connectivity Issues

- Check if your SIM card is properly inserted.
- Restart the device.
- Go to *Settings > Network & internet > Mobile network* and ensure mobile data is enabled and preferred network type is correct.
