- **Rechargeable with Type-C Fast Charging:** Powered by a 2000mAh lithium-ion battery, offering up to 180 minutes of use on a single charge. The Type-C charging port ensures faster, more convenient recharging.
- **User-Friendly LED Display:** A smart LED screen shows battery life, current speed level, and charging status at a glance.
- **Premium Fabric Care:** Engineered for performance and durability with ultra-sharp stainless steel blades for snag-free removal of lint, pills, and fuzz.

3. Safety Instructions

- Keep out of reach of children.
- Do not use on wet fabrics. Ensure fabrics are completely dry before use.
- Avoid pressing too hard on the fabric to prevent damage.
- Always place the protective cover over the blades when not in use or during storage.
- Do not disassemble the unit beyond recommended maintenance steps.
- Use only the provided USB-C cable for charging.

4. Setup

Before first use, fully charge your fabric shaver.

1. Connect the provided USB-C charging cable to the charging port located at the bottom of the shaver.
2. Plug the other end of the USB-C cable into a compatible USB power adapter (not included) or a computer USB port.
3. The LED display will indicate the charging status. A full charge typically takes approximately 3 hours and provides up to 180 minutes of use.

5. Operating Instructions

Follow these steps to effectively remove lint and pilling from your fabrics:

1. **Prepare the Fabric:** Lay the garment or fabric item flat on a hard, smooth surface. Ensure the fabric is taut and free of wrinkles.
2. **Power On & Select Speed:** Press the power button on the shaver. The LED display will light up. Press

the power button again to cycle through the three speed settings (Speed 1 for delicate, Speed 2 for medium, Speed 3 for tough fabrics). Choose the appropriate speed for your fabric type.

3. **Glide Gently:** Gently move the shaver over the affected area in a circular motion or back and forth. Do not press down too hard. Allow the blades to do the work.
4. **Monitor Progress:** Observe the fabric as you work. The shaver will collect lint and fuzz in its transparent collector bin.
5. **Power Off:** Once finished, press the power button until the device turns off. Replace the protective blade cover.

6. Maintenance

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your fabric shaver.

1. **Emptying the Lint Collector:** The oversized collector bin prevents clogs. To empty, gently slide off the transparent lint collector from the handle. Dispose of the collected lint.
2. **Cleaning the Blades:** Use the provided cleaning brush to remove any trapped lint or debris from the blades and the protective mesh. Ensure the device is turned off and unplugged before cleaning.
3. **Blade Replacement:** If the blades become dull or damaged, replace them with the extra blade set included in your package. Carefully remove the old blades and insert the new ones, ensuring they are securely in place.

7. Troubleshooting

- **Device not turning on:** Ensure the device is fully charged. If the battery is low, connect it to the Type-C charger.
- **Ineffective lint removal:** Check if the lint collector is full and needs emptying. Ensure the blades are clean and not dull. Replace blades if necessary.
- **Fabric damage:** Ensure you are using the correct speed setting for the fabric type and not applying excessive pressure.
