Connecting Your Headset

- Wireless USB Connection: Utilize the included wireless receiver for 2.4GHz wireless connectivity with compatible devices such as PC, PS5, PS4, and Nintendo Switch.
- USB-C Cable: Connect the headset directly using the provided USB-C cable for a wired connection.
- USB-A Adapter: An adapter is included to convert the USB-C connection to USB-A, ensuring compatibility with a
 wider range of devices.

Ensure the headset is charged before initial use. Connect the wireless receiver to your desired device's USB port. The headset should automatically pair. If using a wired connection, simply plug the USB-C cable into the headset and your

device.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Power and Battery Life

The HyperX Cloud III Wireless boasts an impressive battery life of up to 120 hours on a single charge, allowing for extended gaming or media consumption without frequent recharging. The headset features a power indicator to inform you of the battery status.



Audio Controls

Convenient controls are located directly on the headset earcup for quick access to essential functions:

- Volume Wheel: Adjust the audio volume up or down.
- **Mic Mute Button:** Quickly mute or unmute your microphone. An LED indicator on the microphone provides visual confirmation of its mute status.



MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your HyperX Cloud III Wireless headset, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- Cleaning: Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe down the earcups and headband. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** Store the headset in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. When not in use, consider placing it in a protective case to prevent dust accumulation and physical damage.
- Cable Care: Handle the USB-C cable and wireless receiver with care. Avoid sharp bends or excessive pulling that could damage the connectors or cable integrity.
- **Microphone Care:** When detaching or reattaching the microphone, do so gently to avoid damaging the port. Keep the microphone clean and free from debris.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your HyperX Cloud III Wireless headset, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

• No Audio/Low Volume:

- Ensure the headset is powered on and fully charged.
- Check the volume wheel on the earcup and your device's audio settings.
- Verify that the wireless receiver is securely plugged into the correct USB port on your device.
- If using a wired connection, ensure the USB-C cable is properly connected.
- Confirm that the HyperX Cloud III Wireless is selected as the default audio output device in your system settings.

• Microphone Not Working:

- Check if the microphone is properly attached and not muted (LED indicator should be off).
- Verify that the HyperX Cloud III Wireless microphone is selected as the default input device in your system's sound settings.
- Adjust the microphone volume in your device's settings or through the HyperX NGENUITY software (if applicable).

• Connectivity Issues:

- Ensure the headset and wireless receiver are within range (up to 20 meters / 65 feet).
- Try plugging the wireless receiver into a different USB port.
- Restart your device and the headset.
- Avoid sources of interference (e.g., other 2.4GHz devices, Wi-Fi routers).

• Sound Quality Issues (Distortion/Static):

- Ensure the headset is fully charged.
- Move closer to the wireless receiver to improve signal strength.
- Check for any physical damage to the headset or cables.
- If using HyperX NGENUITY software, try resetting audio settings or adjusting the equalizer.
