1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Bellemave Twin Over Twin House Bunk Bed. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new bunk bed. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain this manual for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: Failure to follow these warnings and instructions could result in serious injury or death.

- Keep out of reach of children.
- Ensure the upper bunk bed is used by children over 6 years old.
- Do not exceed the weight capacity of 500 LBS for the upper bed.
- Use the ladder with caution and ensure proper handling.
- Always use the recommended mattress size to prevent entrapment or falls.
- Periodically check and ensure that all fasteners are tight.
- Do not allow children to play on or under the bunk bed.
- Do not use substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer for replacement parts.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Your Bellemave Twin Over Twin House Bunk Bed package includes the following components:

- Bed Frame Components (Wood)
- Guardrails
- Slats (13 plywood support slats for the upper bed)
- Detachable Tent
- Assembly Hardware (Iron alloy bolts, screws, etc.)

- Assembly Tools (e.g., Allen wrench)
- Step-by-step Instruction Manual

Note: The bunk bed comes in 2 separate packages, which may arrive on different dates. Please wait patiently for all packages before beginning assembly.

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW AND DIMENSIONS

The Bellemave Twin Over Twin House Bunk Bed features a unique house-shaped design with a detachable tent, providing a cozy and engaging space. It is constructed from sturdy pinewood with iron alloy bolts for stability. The low-profile design of the lower bunk is suitable for younger children, and the upper bunk includes full-length guardrails for safety. The ladder is designed with wider steps for easier access.



6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using the Bunk Bed:

- **Upper Bunk:** Designed for children over 6 years old. Always use the ladder to access the upper bunk. Ensure guardrails are securely in place.
- **Lower Bunk:** Features a low-profile design, making it easily accessible for younger children.
- **Ladder:** The ladder is designed with wider steps for comfortable and safe climbing. Always face the ladder when ascending or descending.
- **Detachable Tent:** The tent can be easily attached or removed to suit preference, providing a playful enclosure for the upper bunk.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your bunk bed.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed feels wobbly or unstable.	Loose hardware or incorrect assembly.	Check all bolts and screws and tighten them securely. Review assembly instructions to ensure all parts are correctly installed.
Screws or bolts do not align with holes during assembly.	Parts may be oriented incorrectly.	Double-check the orientation of the bed frame components against the instruction manual diagrams. Ensure you are using the correct hardware for each step.
Mattress is too high for the safety rail on the upper bunk.	Using a mattress thicker than recommended.	Ensure the mattress used on the upper bunk allows for sufficient guardrail height above the mattress surface to prevent falls. A mattress around 6 inches thick is generally recommended.
Ladder feels flimsy or unstable.	Loose connections or damaged components.	Inspect the ladder for any loose connections and tighten them. If any part of the ladder is damaged, discontinue use and contact customer support for replacement parts.
Tent has an odor after unpacking.	New product odor from packaging materials.	Remove the tent and air it out in a well-ventilated area. If washable, follow care instructions to clean it.
