INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Silvercrest Ice Maker SEMK 105 B2. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new ice maker. Please read these instructions carefully before first use and keep them for future reference.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons.

- Do not immerse the appliance, power cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Ensure the voltage specified on the appliance matches your local power supply.
- Keep the appliance out of reach of children.
- Unplug the appliance from the power outlet when not in use and before cleaning.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Silvercrest Ice Maker SEMK 105 B2 is designed to produce ice cubes quickly and conveniently. It features a 2.1-liter integrated water reservoir, eliminating the need for a direct water connection. You can choose between two ice cube sizes.

SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the ice maker from its packaging. Retain the packaging for future storage or transport.
2. **Placement:** Place the ice maker on a stable, level surface away from direct sunlight and heat sources. Ensure there is adequate ventilation around the appliance, leaving at least 10 cm of space on all sides.
3. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, clean the interior of the ice maker, including the water reservoir and ice basket, with a soft cloth and mild detergent. Rinse thoroughly with clean water and dry.
4. **Water Filling:** Open the lid and fill the water reservoir with potable water up to the MAX fill line. Do not overfill.
5. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet.
6. **First Use:** For the first few cycles, it is recommended to discard the ice cubes produced to ensure optimal hygiene and taste.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Silvercrest Ice Maker features a user-friendly Soft Touch control panel.

1. **Power On:** Press the ON/OFF button on the control panel to turn on the appliance.
2. **Select Ice Cube Size:** Use the 'SELECT' button to choose between two ice cube sizes: small or large. An indicator light will show your selection.
 - Small ice cubes: Approximately 9 cubes in 7 minutes.
 - Large ice cubes: Approximately 9 cubes in 9 minutes.
3. **Ice Production:** The ice maker will automatically begin the ice-making cycle. The appliance can produce approximately 11 to 12 kg of ice in 24 hours.
4. **Ice Full Indicator:** The 'ICE FULL' indicator light will illuminate when the ice basket is full. The appliance will pause operation until ice is removed.

5. **Add Water Indicator:** The 'ADD WATER' indicator light will illuminate when the water reservoir needs refilling. The appliance will pause operation until water is added.
6. **Removing Ice:** Use the provided ice scoop to remove ice cubes from the removable ice basket.

MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning and maintenance will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your ice maker.

- **Daily Cleaning:** After each use, drain any remaining water from the reservoir. Clean the interior with a soft cloth.
- **Weekly Cleaning:** For a more thorough cleaning, remove the ice basket and wash it with warm, soapy water. Clean the water reservoir and ice-making components with a solution of water and vinegar (1:1 ratio) to prevent mineral buildup. Rinse thoroughly with clean water.
- **Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior of the appliance with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** If storing the ice maker for an extended period, ensure it is completely dry. Store it in a cool, dry place, preferably in its original packaging.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your ice maker, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Ice maker not producing ice.	No water in reservoir; power not connected; ambient temperature too high.	Fill water reservoir; check power connection; move appliance to a cooler location.
Ice cubes are too small or misshapen.	Insufficient water; water temperature too high.	Ensure water level is adequate; use colder water.
"ADD WATER" indicator is on.	Water reservoir is empty.	Refill the water reservoir with potable water.
"ICE FULL" indicator is on.	Ice basket is full.	Remove ice from the basket.
