PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Main Unit

The ALPOWL AL-001 features a compact design with integrated speakers and a control panel. It includes a phone/tablet dock for convenient media display.




Figure 3: Top View of the Karaoke Machine

Control Panel and Ports

The main unit's control panel includes buttons for mode selection, music/original sound toggle, LED light control, volume adjustment, and track navigation. The rear panel houses various input ports for versatile connectivity.

Wireless Microphones

Two UHF wireless microphones are included, featuring individual controls for volume, echo, and EQ, along with an LED display for status and battery life.

SETUP

1. Charging the Karaoke Machine

- 1. Connect the USB charging cable to the DC-5V port on the rear of the karaoke machine.
- 2. Plug the other end of the USB cable into a compatible USB power adapter (not included) or a powered USB port.
- 3. Allow the unit to charge fully before first use. The charging indicator will show status.

2. Charging the Wireless Microphones

Microphones can be charged in two ways:

- Via Speaker Dock: Place the microphones into the designated charging docks on the main karaoke machine unit. Ensure they are properly seated.
- **Individual Type-C Charging:** Connect a Type-C charging cable (not included) directly to the charging port on each microphone.

3. Powering On/Off

- Main Unit: Use the ON/OFF switch located on the rear panel.
- Microphones: Press and hold the power button on each microphone until the display illuminates.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Bluetooth Connection

- 1. Power on the karaoke machine. The display will show "BLUE" indicating Bluetooth mode.
- 2. Enable Bluetooth on your device (smartphone, tablet, laptop, etc.).
- 3. Search for "ALPOWL" in your device's Bluetooth settings and select it to pair.
- 4. A confirmation sound will indicate successful pairing.

2. Using the Wireless Microphones

- Power On: Press and hold the power button on the microphone.
- Volume Control: Use the "VOL+" and "VOL-" buttons on the microphone to adjust your vocal volume.
- Echo Adjustment: Use the "ECH+" and "ECH-" buttons to control the echo effect.
- EQ Modes: Press the "EQ" button to cycle through different equalization presets.
- Frequency Adjustment (A=B): Long press the "A=B" button for 2 seconds to change the microphone's frequency band (CHA or CHB). This is crucial for duet mode.

3. Duet Mode

To use both microphones simultaneously for a duet:

- 1. Ensure both microphones are powered on.
- 2. Set one microphone to frequency band "CHA" by long-pressing the "A=B" button.
- 3. Set the second microphone to frequency band "CHB" by long-pressing the "A=B" button.
- 4. Both microphones can now be used for duets. If both are on the same frequency band, only one will function.

4. LED Lights Control

The speaker features colorful LED lights with 7 color modes. Short press the "LED" button on the main unit to switch between modes. The spectral screen light in the middle changes with the music and displays microphone connection status, power, and connection mode.

5. Other Input Modes

In addition to Bluetooth, the machine supports:

- USB Flash Drive: Insert a USB drive into the USB port on the rear panel to play audio files.
- **TF Card:** Insert a TF (MicroSD) card into the TF card slot on the rear panel to play audio files.
- AUX Input: Connect an external audio device using the provided AUX cable to the AUX port on the rear panel.

6. Music/Original Sound Toggle

Press the "Music/Orig" button on the main unit to switch between playing the original music track and removing the vocal track for karaoke.

MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning: Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the surface of the karaoke machine and microphones. Do not use liquid cleaners.
- Battery Care: If the machine is not used for an extended period, ensure the battery is not completely depleted.

 Charge the machine and microphones for at least 30 minutes before turning them on if they have been unused for a long time. Avoid turning on a completely drained unit immediately after plugging it in, as this can damage the battery.
- Storage: Store the unit in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound from speaker.	Volume too low; device not connected; incorrect mode.	Increase volume on both the machine and connected device. Ensure Bluetooth is paired or correct input mode (USB/TF/AUX) is selected.
Microphone not working.	Microphone off; low battery; incorrect frequency; too far from unit.	Power on microphone. Charge microphone. Ensure microphone is on a unique frequency (CHA/CHB for duets). Stay within 33 feet (10 meters) of the unit.
Poor sound quality/static.	Interference; microphone too far; low battery.	Change microphone frequency. Move closer to the unit. Charge microphones.
LED lights not working.	LED function turned off.	Press the "LED" button on the main unit to activate or change modes.
Unit not charging/powering on.	Charging cable issue; completely drained battery.	Check charging cable connection. If battery is completely drained, charge for over 30 minutes before attempting to power on.
