1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Vandlion A32 Full 1080P HD Body Worn Camera. It features 1080P Full-HD video recording, a 180-degree rotatable lens, and support for external MicroSD/TF cards.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

2.1 Camera Components

- **180° Rotatable Lens:** Allows for flexible recording angles.
- **Display Screen:** For live view, playback, and menu navigation.

- **Control Buttons:** Power, Record, Audio Save, Playback, Menu, Navigation, Volume.
- **MicroSD Card Slot:** For external memory storage.
- **USB Port:** For charging and data transfer.
- **Integrated Clip:** For attaching the camera to clothing or gear.

3. SETUP

3.1 Charging the Camera

Before first use, fully charge the camera. Connect the camera to a USB power adapter or a computer's USB port using the provided USB cable. The charging indicator will show the charging status. A full charge typically takes approximately 3 hours.

3.2 Inserting a MicroSD Card

The Vandlion A32 does not have built-in memory and requires an external MicroSD/TF card for recording. It supports cards up to 128GB. Ensure the camera is powered off before inserting or removing the memory card.

1. Locate the MicroSD card slot on the side of the camera.
2. Gently insert the MicroSD card into the slot with the gold contacts facing down until it clicks into place.
3. To remove, push the card in slightly until it springs out.

4. OPERATING THE CAMERA

4.1 Power On/Off

Press and hold the Power button to turn the camera on or off.

4.2 Recording Video

Press the 'SAVE=VIDEO' button to start video recording. Press it again to stop and save the recording.

4.3 Recording Audio Only

Press the 'AUDIO=SAVE' button to start audio-only recording. Press it again to stop and save the audio file.

4.4 Taking Photos

While in standby mode, press the designated photo button (if available, or refer to on-screen menu) to capture a still image.

4.5 Playback

Use the 'PLAY' button to enter playback mode. Use 'PREV' and 'NEXT' buttons to navigate through recorded files. Adjust volume with 'VOL+' and 'VOL-' buttons.

4.6 Menu Navigation

Press the 'MENU' button to access camera settings. Use the navigation buttons to scroll and select options.

4.7 180° Rotatable Lens

The camera features a lens that can be manually rotated 180 degrees to capture footage from different angles without repositioning the entire device.

5. FILE TRANSFER & PC CAMERA MODE

To transfer files or use the camera as a PC webcam:

1. Connect the camera to your computer using the USB cable.
2. The camera will appear as a removable disk drive on your computer. You can then access, copy, or delete recorded files.
3. Some operating systems may prompt you to select a mode (e.g., Mass Storage or PC Camera). Select 'PC Camera' to use it as a webcam.

6. MAINTENANCE

- Keep the camera clean. Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the body.
- For the lens, use a specialized lens cleaning cloth.
- Avoid exposing the camera to extreme temperatures, direct sunlight, or moisture.
- Do not attempt to disassemble the camera, as this will void the warranty.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

7.1 Camera Not Turning On

- Ensure the battery is charged. Connect to a power source and allow it to charge for at least 30 minutes before attempting to power on.
- If unresponsive, try pressing the 'Reset' button (if available, often a small pinhole).

7.2 Cannot Record

- Check if a MicroSD card is properly inserted.
- Ensure the MicroSD card has sufficient free space.
- Format the MicroSD card (via camera menu or computer) if it's a new card or experiencing issues.

7.3 Poor Video Quality

- Ensure the lens is clean and free from smudges.
- Check lighting conditions.

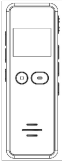
