INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Drefirsa 1:18 Remote Control Monster Truck, Model 1220A. This manual provides essential information for the safe operation, setup, and maintenance of your new RC truck. Please read it thoroughly before use to ensure optimal performance and longevity of the product.

SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING:

- Not suitable for children under 36 months due to small parts which may present a choking hazard.

- Always operate the RC truck in open areas, away from people, pets, and obstacles.
- Do not operate near water or in wet conditions to prevent damage to electronic components.
- Ensure batteries are charged and handled according to instructions to avoid fire or injury.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

- RC Truck ×1
- 2.4GHz Radio Control ×1
- Rechargeable Battery for Truck ×2

- Remote Controller Battery (AA) ×2
- Charging Cable ×1
- Screwdriver ×1

SETUP

1. Battery Installation for the RC Truck

1. Using the provided screwdriver, carefully open the battery compartment cover located on the underside of the RC truck.
2. Connect one of the rechargeable Lithium Ion batteries to the truck's battery connector.
3. Place the battery securely into the compartment and close the cover. Fasten with the screw.

2. Battery Installation for the Remote Control

1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of the 2.4GHz remote control.
2. Open the cover and insert the two AA batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).

3. Close the battery compartment cover.

3. Charging the RC Truck Batteries

1. Connect the rechargeable Lithium Ion battery to the charging cable.
2. Plug the USB end of the charging cable into a standard USB power adapter (not included) or a computer USB port.
3. The indicator light on the charging cable will show the charging status. Refer to the charging cable's specific instructions for light indications.
4. Once fully charged, disconnect the battery from the charging cable and the power source.
5. Each battery provides approximately 20+ minutes of playtime. Two batteries are included for extended use.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Pairing the Remote Control with the Truck

1. Ensure both the RC truck and the remote control have fresh or fully charged batteries installed.
2. Turn on the RC truck using the power switch.
3. Turn on the remote control. The indicator light on the remote will flash, then become solid once paired.
4. If pairing fails, turn off both devices and repeat the steps.

2. Remote Control Functions

- **Steering Wheel:** Rotate left to turn the truck left, rotate right to turn the truck right.
- **Trigger:** Pull the trigger towards you to move the truck forward. Push the trigger away from you to move the truck backward.
- **ON/OFF Power Switch:** Powers the remote control on or off.
- The 2.4GHz frequency provides a stable signal and allows for multiple vehicles to operate simultaneously without interference.

3. Driving the RC Truck

- The truck is designed for all-terrain use, capable of operating on gravel, grass, sand, and mud due to its high torque motor and advanced tread tires.
- It features LED headlights and color-changing body lights for enhanced visibility and visual appeal during operation.
- **Drift Capabilities:** To perform a drift, while moving forward, quickly press reverse and emergency stop, then switch direction. This maneuver requires practice.

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning

- After each use, especially on dirty or dusty surfaces, gently wipe the truck with a soft, dry cloth to remove dirt and debris.
- Avoid using water or chemical cleaners, as they can damage electronic components.
- Periodically check the wheels and axles for any tangled hair or debris that might impede movement.

2. Storage

- When not in use, store the RC truck and remote control in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Remove batteries from both the truck and the remote control if storing for an extended period to prevent leakage and damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|---|--|---|
| Truck does not move or respond to remote. | Low batteries in truck or remote; Not paired; Power switch off. | Charge/replace batteries; Re-pair truck and remote; Ensure power switches are ON. |
| Short control range or intermittent signal. | Interference; Low remote battery. | Move to an area with less interference; Replace remote batteries. |
| Truck moves slowly or lacks power. | Low truck battery. | Recharge the truck battery. |
| Wheels are stuck or not turning freely. | Debris in axles; Damaged wheel. | Remove debris; Inspect for damage. |
