INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the Igloo 3.2 Cu.Ft. Single Door Compact Refrigerator with Freezer. This appliance is designed for convenient food and beverage storage in various settings such as homes, offices, and dormitories. Please read this manual thoroughly before operation to ensure proper use, maintenance, and safety.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons.

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Do not touch cold surfaces, especially when hands are damp or wet. Skin may stick to extremely cold surfaces.
- Ensure the refrigerator is properly grounded.
- Unplug the refrigerator before cleaning or making repairs.
- Do not store explosive substances such as aerosol cans with a flammable propellant in this appliance.
- Keep ventilation openings clear of obstruction.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Igloo 3.2 Cu.Ft. Compact Refrigerator features a single door design with a separate freezer compartment. It includes adjustable glass shelves and door storage for optimal organization.

- Capacity: Spacious 3.2 Cu. Ft.
- Cooling Range: Refrigerator section maintains temperatures between 32°F and 50°F.
- Freezer: Dedicated compartment for frozen foods.
- Thermostat: Adjustable mechanical temperature control for precise cooling.
- Cooling Type: Compressor static cooling, no fan, ensuring quiet operation.
- Shelves: Slide-out glass shelves for easy cleaning and organization.

SETUP

Unpacking and Placement

- 1. Remove all packaging materials, including the foam base and adhesive tape.
- 2. Clean the interior and exterior of the refrigerator with a soft cloth and mild detergent.
- 3. Place the refrigerator on a firm, level surface away from direct sunlight or heat sources. Ensure there is adequate air circulation around the unit (at least 4 inches of space on the sides and back).
- 4. Allow the appliance to stand upright for at least 2-4 hours before plugging it in. This allows the refrigerant to settle.

Electrical Connection

Plug the refrigerator into a dedicated 120 Volt, 60 Hz, 15 Amp grounded electrical outlet. Do not use extension cords or adapter plugs.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Temperature Control


The temperature is controlled by a mechanical thermostat located inside the refrigerator compartment. Turn the dial to adjust the cooling level:

- "0" (OFF): Turns the cooling system off.
- "1" (MIN): Least cold setting.
- "4" (MAX): Coldest setting.

For optimal performance, it is recommended to start at a medium setting (e.g., "2" or "3") and adjust as needed based on ambient temperature and food load.

Food Storage

- Store perishable foods in the main refrigerator compartment.
- Use the separate freezer compartment for items requiring freezing.
- Do not overload the shelves or door bins to allow for proper air circulation.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

Regular cleaning helps maintain the efficiency and appearance of your refrigerator.

1. Unplug the refrigerator from the power outlet before cleaning.

- 2. Wash the interior with a solution of warm water and baking soda (2 tablespoons of baking soda to 1 quart of water).
- 3. Clean the door gasket with a mild detergent and warm water.
- 4. Wipe the exterior with a soft cloth and mild detergent.
- 5. Dry all surfaces thoroughly.

Defrosting the Freezer

The freezer compartment will accumulate frost over time. Defrost when the frost layer is about 1/4 inch thick.

- 1. Unplug the refrigerator.
- 2. Remove all food from the freezer and place it in another cooler.
- 3. Leave the freezer door open to allow frost to melt naturally. You can place a towel at the bottom to absorb water.
- 4. Do not use sharp objects or heating devices to remove frost.
- 5. Once defrosted, clean and dry the freezer interior before plugging the unit back in.


TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Refrigerator does not operate.	Not plugged in; circuit breaker tripped; temperature control set to "0".	Check power cord; reset circuit breaker; adjust temperature control.
Temperature is too warm.	Door opened too frequently; warm food placed inside; poor air circulation; thermostat setting too low.	Minimize door openings; allow hot food to cool before placing inside; ensure proper clearance; adjust thermostat to a colder setting.
Excessive frost buildup in freezer.	Door not sealed properly; high humidity; frequent door openings.	Check door gasket for proper seal; avoid opening door unnecessarily; defrost as needed.
Unusual noises.	Refrigerator not level; objects vibrating against the unit; normal compressor operation.	Adjust leveling feet; ensure nothing is touching the back or sides; gurgling/hissing sounds are normal.




Figure 7: U.S. Government Energy Guide for model IRF32BK6A.
