# SUBZERO Wireless Dual Digital Microphone System User Manual

Model: B0CCF98JTG

#### 1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your SUBZERO Wireless Dual Digital Microphone System. Please read this manual thoroughly before use and retain it for future reference. The SUBZERO Wireless Dual Digital Microphone System offers crystal-clear wireless audio with two handheld microphones, operating within the 2.4GHz frequency band. It features quick setup and a reliable range of up to 30 meters.

#### 2. SAFETY INFORMATION AND WARNINGS

**WARNING!** To reduce the risk of electric shock, fire, or damage to the unit, always observe the following precautions:

- Do not open. No user-serviceable parts inside. Refer servicing to qualified service personnel.
- Do not place this product in a location near a heat source such as a radiator, or in an area subject to direct sunlight, excessive dust, mechanical vibration or shock.
- The product must not be exposed to dripping or splashing and no objects filled with liquids, such as vases, shall be placed on the product.
- No naked flame sources, such as lighted candles, should be placed on the product.
- Pay attention to the environmental aspects of battery disposal.
- The product is designed for use in moderate climates.
- Only use attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer.
- · Unplug this apparatus during lightning storms or when unused for long periods of time.

#### 4. PRODUCT FEATURES

- Two digital wireless microphones with balanced XLR and Jack outputs.
- 16 channels within the 2.4GHz frequency band for enhanced flexibility.
- · Quick setup with hassle-free infrared pairing.
- Crystal-clear wireless audio up to a 30-meter range, free from interference.

#### 5. SETUP GUIDE

#### **5.1 Receiver Placement**

Place the receiver unit on a stable, flat surface, away from sources of interference such as Wi-Fi routers, microwave ovens, or large metal objects. Ensure adequate ventilation around the unit.

#### 5.2 Connecting the Receiver

- 1. Connect the included power adapter to the DC 12V input on the rear of the receiver and plug it into a power outlet.
- 2. Connect the receiver's audio output (XLR or 6.35mm Jack) to your mixer, amplifier, or audio interface using an appropriate audio cable.

## **5.3 Microphone Battery Installation**

Unscrew the bottom part of each handheld microphone to access the battery compartment. Insert two AA batteries (not included) into each microphone, ensuring correct polarity.

#### 6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

## **6.1 Powering On**

- 1. Press the power button on the receiver unit. The display will illuminate.
- 2. Press and hold the power button on each handheld microphone until its display illuminates.

## 6.2 Infrared Pairing

The system uses infrared (IR) pairing for quick and automatic synchronization between the receiver and microphones.

- 1. On the receiver, select the desired channel for pairing (e.g., Channel A or B).
- 2. On the microphone, activate the IR pairing mode (refer to the microphone's small display for instructions, usually by pressing a button near the IR sensor).
- 3. Align the IR sensor on the microphone with the IR window on the receiver (usually near the display). The

devices will automatically sync.

4. Repeat for the second microphone.

## **6.3 Adjusting Volume**

Use the dedicated volume knobs on the receiver for Channel A and Channel B to adjust the output level of each microphone independently.

If you experience interference, you can change the operating channel. Use the channel selection buttons on the receiver to cycle through the available 16 channels. Ensure the paired microphone also updates to the new channel via IR pairing if necessary.

#### 7. MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning: Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the receiver and microphones. Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or waxes
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the system in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Remove batteries from microphones before storage to prevent leakage.
- **Battery Replacement:** Replace microphone batteries when the low battery indicator appears on the microphone display or when audio quality degrades.

## 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound from microphone	Microphone not powered on; Batteries low/incorrectly installed; Microphone not paired; Receiver not connected to audio system; Receiver volume too low.	Ensure microphone is on; Replace batteries, check polarity; Perform IR pairing; Check audio cable connections; Increase receiver volume.
Interference or static noise	Other wireless devices nearby; Operating too far from receiver; Obstructions between microphone and receiver.	Change receiver channel; Move closer to receiver; Ensure clear line of sight; Turn off other interfering wireless devices.
Short wireless range	Obstructions; Environmental interference; Low microphone batteries.	Ensure clear line of sight; Change channel; Replace microphone batteries.
Receiver display not working	Power adapter not connected; Power button not pressed.	Check power adapter connection; Press receiver power button.
