INTRODUCTION

The Nerf Elite Junior Racer dart blaster is designed for ease of use, making it suitable for children aged 6 and up who are new to Nerf battles. Its lightweight design and simple operation allow for quick and engaging play.

SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: Small parts may be generated. Not for children under 3 years.

- Do not aim at eyes or face.
- Eyewear is recommended (not included) for players and people within range.
- Use only official NERF darts. Other darts may not meet safety standards.
- Do not modify darts or blaster.

SETUP

1. Carefully remove the blaster and darts from the packaging.
2. Inspect the blaster and darts for any damage. Do not use if damaged.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Load Darts:** Insert up to two Nerf Elite darts into the front barrels of the blaster. Ensure darts are fully inserted.

2. **Prime the Blaster:** Pull back the green handle located at the rear of the blaster until it clicks into place. This action primes the blaster for firing. The blaster handle has the lowest pull force of any Nerf dart blasters, making it easy for kids to operate.

3. **Aim and Fire:** Aim the blaster at your target. Press the trigger to launch a dart. The blaster fires one dart at a time.

4. **Reload:** After firing, repeat steps 1-3 to continue playing.

The Nerf Elite Junior Racer blaster fires 2 darts in a row before needing a full reload of both barrels.

- Keep the blaster clean by wiping it with a damp cloth. Do not submerge in water.
- Store darts in a clean, dry place to maintain their shape and performance.
- Avoid exposing the blaster to extreme temperatures or direct sunlight for prolonged periods.

Dart does not fire or fires weakly.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure the dart is fully inserted into the barrel.• Make sure the blaster is fully primed by pulling the handle back until it clicks.• Check if the dart is damaged or worn. Use new, official Nerf Elite darts.
Blaster handle is difficult to pull back.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure no darts are jammed in the mechanism.• If the issue persists, contact customer support.
