1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your AUFANK Full Size Four-Poster Metal Canopy Bed Frame. Please read this manual thoroughly before assembly and use to ensure proper function and safety.

The AUFANK Full Size Four-Poster Metal Canopy Bed Frame is designed to provide a sturdy and stylish foundation for your mattress without the need for a box spring. Its metal construction ensures durability and stability for a comfortable sleep experience.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

CAUTION:

- This bed frame is heavy and may cause injury if not handled carefully during assembly. It is recommended to have at least two people for assembly.
- Do not exceed the weight limit of 150 pounds.
- Be cautious of slippery surfaces when cleaning the frame with a damp cloth.
- Ensure all screws and connections are tightened securely before use and periodically check for looseness.

3. Parts List

Before beginning assembly, verify that all components listed below are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, please contact customer support.

- Screw bags
- Support legs
- Headboard

• Other frame components (side rails, footboard, canopy posts, etc.)

Note: An Allen wrench is typically included for assembly.

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the AUFANK bed frame is designed to be straightforward with the included instructions. While it can be assembled by one person, having an extra hand will make the process significantly easier and quicker.

4.1 Preparation

- 1. Unpack all components and lay them out on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratches.
- 2. Identify each part using the provided parts list and diagrams in the instruction book.
- 3. Ensure you have the necessary tools, typically an Allen wrench (usually included).

4.2 Assembly Steps

Follow the step-by-step diagrams and instructions provided in the separate instruction book included with your bed frame. The general process involves:

- 1. Assembling the headboard and footboard sections.
- 2. Connecting the side rails to the headboard and footboard.
- 3. Attaching the support legs.
- 4. Installing the canopy posts and top rails.
- 5. Placing the slats onto the frame.

4.3 Assembly Tips

- Review Instructions: Read through all instructions before starting.
- Two-Person Assembly: While possible alone, assembly is significantly easier and safer with two people.
- Slats Installation: It is recommended to install the E slats (if applicable) after the main frame structure is complete to allow for easier maneuvering during assembly.
- Screw Type: The bed frame primarily uses Allen screws.
- Extra Parts: It is common for a few extra parts to be included; do not be concerned if you have some left over after assembly.
- Tightening: Ensure all screws are tightened securely to prevent wobbling or creaking.

5. OPERATION

5.1 Mattress Compatibility

This bed frame is designed to perfectly fit a Full size mattress. A box spring is not needed due to the sturdy slatted structure. The frame is engineered to provide the correct fit without being too wide or too narrow for standard Full mattresses.

6. MAINTENANCE

To maintain the appearance and longevity of your AUFANK bed frame, follow these simple care instructions:

- Cleaning: Wipe the metal frame with a damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that could damage the powder-coated finish.
- **Tightening:** Periodically check all screws and connections to ensure they remain tight. Re-tighten as necessary to maintain stability and prevent squeaking.
- Weight Limit: Do not exceed the stated weight limit to prevent damage to the frame.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your bed frame.

7.1 Bed Frame Squeaks or Creaks

If your bed frame is making noise, it is usually due to loose connections.

- **Solution:** Systematically check and tighten all screws and bolts on the entire frame, including the headboard, footboard, side rails, and support legs. Ensure the slats are properly seated and secured.
- **Tip:** Some users have found that applying felt strips or similar material to the slats where they contact the frame can further reduce noise.

7.2 Mattress Slides on Frame

If your mattress tends to slide, especially when getting on or off the bed, there are a few remedies.

• **Solution:** Place a non-slip mattress pad or rubber mat between the mattress and the bed slats. Some users have also found success by sticking anti-slip strips onto the slats.

7.3 Decorative Balls on Top are Loose

The decorative finials on the canopy posts may become loose over time.

• **Solution:** These can often be tightened by hand. If they continue to loosen, a small amount of Teflon tape wrapped around the screw threads before re-attaching can provide a more secure fit.

7.4 Screw Does Not Fit

In rare cases, a screw might not fit properly during assembly.

• **Solution:** Double-check that you are using the correct screw for the designated hole as per the instruction manual. If the issue persists, contact customer support for a replacement part.
