- Recording Capability: Convert Vinyl, Aux-in, CD, and Cassette to USB/SD (MP3 Format). Also record USB/SD, CD, Vinyl, and Aux-in directly to Cassette.
- 3-Speed Belt Drive Turntable: Plays 7, 10, and 12-inch vinyl discs at 33 1/3, 45, and 78 RPM. Features an autostop setting.

## 4. SETUP GUIDE

- 1. **Unboxing:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Retain packaging for future storage or transport.
- 2. **Placement:** Place the main unit on a stable, flat surface away from direct sunlight, heat sources, and excessive dust or moisture. Ensure adequate ventilation around the unit.
- 3. **Speaker Connection:** Connect the included external speakers to the speaker output ports on the main unit. Ensure correct polarity (positive to positive, negative to negative).
- 4. **Power Connection:** Plug the AC power cord into a standard wall outlet. The unit has an on-mode power consumption of 25 watts.
- 5. Initial Power On: Press the Power button on the unit or the remote control to turn on the device.

### 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

## 5.1. Vinyl Record Playback

- 1. Lift the dust cover.
- 2. Place a vinyl record on the turntable platter.
- 3. Select the appropriate speed (33 1/3, 45, or 78 RPM) using the speed selector switch located near the platter. Use the 45 RPM adapter for 7-inch records.
- 4. Release the tone arm lock.
- 5. Gently lift the tone arm using the cueing lever and position it over the desired track of the record.
- 6. Lower the tone arm slowly onto the record using the cueing lever. Playback will begin.
- 7. At the end of the record, the auto-stop function will stop the platter (if enabled). Lift the tone arm and return it to its rest.
