# 1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the ASAKUKI 3L Top Fill Cool Mist Humidifier & Aroma Diffuser. This device is designed to improve air quality and comfort in your home by adding moisture to the air and allowing for aromatherapy. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure proper operation and maintenance.

# 2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Always place the humidifier on a firm, flat, waterproof surface at least 12 inches (30 cm) away from walls and appliances.
- Do not place the humidifier directly on carpet or a towel.
- Keep the humidifier out of reach of children and pets.
- Use only clean, cool tap water or distilled water. Do not use hot water.
- Do not add essential oils directly into the water tank. Use the designated aroma tray.
- Unplug the humidifier before filling, cleaning, or moving it.
- Do not block the mist outlet or air intake.
- If the humidifier is damaged, do not operate it. Contact customer support.

- This product features an automatic shut-off function when water levels are low, ensuring safety.
- The humidifier is constructed from BPA-free materials, making it safe for use in environments with babies and children.

# 4. PRODUCT DIAGRAM

Familiarize yourself with the components of your humidifier:

- 1. Mist Nozzle (360° Rotatable)
- 2. Water Tank (3L Capacity)
- 3. Water Level Window
- 4. Control Knob (Mist Level / Power)
- 5. Night Light Button
- 6. Aroma Tray
- 7. Base Unit

## 5. SETUP

#### **5.1 Initial Placement**

Place the humidifier on a flat, stable surface. Ensure it is not near heat sources or direct sunlight. Maintain adequate space around the unit for optimal mist dispersion.

## 5.2 Filling the Water Tank

- 1. Remove the top cover of the humidifier.
- 2. Pour clean, cool tap water or distilled water directly into the water tank through the large top opening. Do not exceed the maximum water level indicator.
- 3. Replace the top cover securely.

## 5.3 Aroma Diffuser Setup

- 1. Locate the aroma tray on the side of the humidifier base.
- 2. Pull out the aroma tray.
- 3. Add a few drops of your preferred essential oil onto the included aroma pad. Alternatively, use the provided lavender scented pad.
- 4. Insert the aroma pad back into the tray and slide the tray back into the humidifier.

Note: Do not add essential oils directly into the water tank, as this can damage the unit.

## 6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

## 6.1 Power On/Off and Mist Level Adjustment

- 1. Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.
- 2. Turn the control knob clockwise to power on the humidifier and adjust the mist output from minimum to maximum.
- 3. Turn the control knob counter-clockwise to the 'OFF' position to power off the humidifier.

#### **6.2 Night Light Function**

Press the night light button to turn the blue night light on or off. This feature can be used independently of the mist function.

#### 6.3 Auto Shut-Off

The humidifier is equipped with an automatic shut-off feature that activates when the water level is too low, preventing damage to the unit and ensuring safety.

# 7. MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning is essential for optimal performance and hygiene.

# 7.1 Regular Cleaning (Every 3 Days Recommended)

- 1. Unplug the humidifier and remove the top cover.
- 2. Empty any remaining water from the tank and base.
- 3. Wipe the inside of the water tank and the base with a soft, damp cloth.
- 4. For thorough cleaning, the mist tube is detachable. Remove it and clean separately.
- 5. Rinse all components thoroughly with clean water.
- 6. Allow all parts to air dry completely before reassembling or storing.

#### 7.2 Descaling (Weekly or Bi-weekly, depending on water hardness)

- 1. Unplug the humidifier.
- 2. Pour 1 cup (240ml) of white vinegar into the water tank and base.
- 3. Let it soak for 30 minutes.
- 4. Use a soft brush or cloth to clean any mineral buildup.
- 5. Empty the vinegar and rinse all components thoroughly with clean water until the vinegar smell is gone.

## 7.3 Aroma Pad Replacement

Replace the aroma pad when the scent diminishes or if you wish to change essential oils. Additional aroma pads are available for purchase.

#### 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No mist or low mist output	Low water level Mineral buildup Mist nozzle blocked	Refill water tank Clean the transducer and base with vinegar Clear any obstructions from the mist nozzle
Unusual odor	Dirty water tank Old water	Clean the water tank and base thoroughly Replace with fresh water
Water leakage	Overfilled water tank Unit not on a level surface Damaged tank/seal	Do not overfill Place on a flat, stable surface Contact customer support
Night light not working	Light button not pressed Malfunction	Press the night light button Contact customer support
