1. INTRODUCTION

The Katalic Automatic Pet Feeder PF02-1 is designed to provide consistent and controlled feeding for your pets, ensuring they receive their meals on time, every time. With programmable meal times, adjustable portion sizes, and a voice recording feature, this feeder offers convenience and peace of mind for pet owners.

2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

3. PRODUCT FEATURES

- **Large Capacity:** 16.9 cups / 140.8 oz (4L) food storage.
- **Flexible Feeding Schedule:** Program up to 4 meals daily.
- **Precise Portion Control:** Dispense 0-20 portions per meal.
- **Dual Power Supply:** Operates via AC adapter or 3 x D batteries (not included) for backup.
- **Voice Recorder:** Record a 10-second message to call your pet.
- **Clog-Free Design:** Engineered to prevent food blockages.
- **Secure Lid:** Keeps food fresh and prevents pets from accessing the food tank.
- **Easy to Clean:** Detachable components for convenient washing.
- **Durable Bowl:** Includes a 304 stainless steel food bowl.

4. SETUP

4.1 Assembly

1. Place the main feeder unit on a flat, stable surface.
2. Insert the food tray into the designated slot at the bottom front of the feeder.
3. Place the stainless steel bowl into the food tray.

4.2 Power Supply

The feeder can be powered by the included AC adapter or by D batteries for backup.

- **AC Adapter:** Plug the power adapter into the DC port on the back of the feeder, then plug the adapter into a standard wall outlet.
- **Battery Backup:** For power outages, install 3 x D alkaline batteries (not included) into the battery compartment on the bottom of the feeder. This ensures continuous operation.

The battery is used for emergency when the power is cut off.

4.3 Filling the Food Tank

1. Open the top lid of the feeder.
2. Insert the desiccant bag into the designated slot under the lid to keep food fresh.
3. Pour dry pet food into the food tank. Ensure the kibble size is between 2-16mm (0.07-0.6 inches) to prevent clogging.
4. Close the lid securely until you hear a click. The lid is designed to lock to prevent pets from opening it.



Use 3 D alkaline batteries as a backup power source for peace of mind during a power outage

Get rid of the trouble of tangled wires, and place it wherever you want.

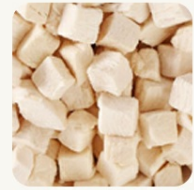
Recommended Food Types

Reminder: Do not use any kibble over 16mm, or it may get stuck inside the feeder and fail to feed your pet

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Control Panel Overview

The control panel features an LCD display and several buttons for programming:

- **SET:** Enter programming mode or confirm settings.
- **UP/DOWN Arrows:** Navigate menus and adjust values.
- **REC:** Record or play voice message.
- **PLAY:** Play recorded voice message.
- **FEED:** Manually dispense one portion of food.

5.2 Setting Current Time

1. Press and hold the **SET** button until the hour digit flashes.
2. Use the **UP/DOWN** arrows to adjust the hour.
3. Press **SET** to confirm and move to minutes.
4. Use the **UP/DOWN** arrows to adjust the minutes.
5. Press **SET** to save the current time.

5.3 Setting Feeding Schedule

You can program up to 4 meals per day with adjustable portion sizes.

1. Press **SET** once to enter meal setting mode (M1 will flash).
2. Use **UP/DOWN** arrows to select the meal number (M1-M4).
3. Press **SET** to set the meal time. Adjust hour and minute using **UP/DOWN** arrows, confirming each with **SET**.
4. After setting the time, the portion number will flash. Use **UP/DOWN** arrows to set the desired portions (1-20).
5. Press **SET** to confirm the portions for the current meal.
6. Repeat steps 2-5 for additional meals (M2, M3, M4) as needed. If a meal is not set, it will not dispense.

5.4 Voice Recording

Record a 10-second voice message that will play at each scheduled feeding time.

1. Press and hold the **REC** button until you hear a beep.
2. Speak your message into the microphone (located near the control panel).
3. Release the **REC** button when finished.
4. Press the **PLAY** button to listen to your recorded message.

5.5 Manual Feeding

To dispense food manually, simply press the **FEED** button. Each press will dispense one portion.

5.6 Portion Calculation Reference

Use the following table as a reference for calculating portions. Note that 1 portion is approximately 2.5 tsp or 1/20 cup.

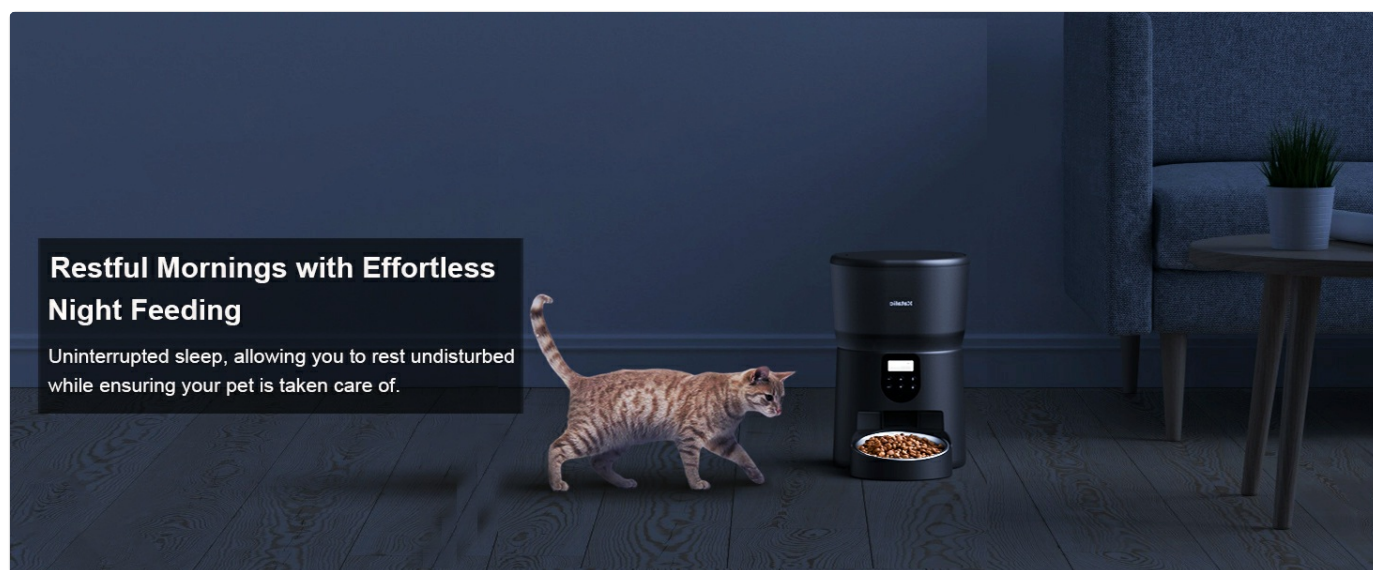


Image: Portion calculation reference table.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning Instructions

Regular cleaning ensures hygiene and optimal performance of your feeder.

1. Unplug the feeder and remove any batteries.
2. Remove the food tank, lid, food tray, and stainless steel bowl.
3. Wash the food tank, lid, food tray, and stainless steel bowl with mild soap and water.
4. Rinse thoroughly and ensure all parts are completely dry before reassembly.
5. **DO NOT wash the main base unit.** Wipe the exterior of the base unit with a damp cloth only.

6. Replace the desiccant bag every 1-2 months for optimal food freshness.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Feeder not dispensing food.	Food tank empty; food clogged; low battery; power disconnected.	Refill food tank; check for clogs and clear; replace batteries or connect AC power.
Incorrect portion size dispensed.	Incorrect portion setting; kibble size too large/small.	Re-program portion size; ensure kibble is within 2-16mm.
Voice recording not playing.	No message recorded; low volume.	Record a message; check volume settings (if applicable, or re-record).
Display not working.	No power; loose connection.	Check power adapter connection; replace batteries.
