


Image: Westinghouse Roku TV with remote and stand, illustrating the contents of the box.

SETUP

Attaching the TV Stand

If placing the TV on a table or entertainment unit, attach the included stand pieces to the bottom of the TV. Ensure screws are tightened securely to prevent instability.

Wall Mounting

For wall mounting, the TV supports a VESA mount standard of 200 x 200 mm. A wall mount kit is not included and must be purchased separately. Follow the instructions provided with your wall mount kit for safe and secure installation.

Power Connection

Connect the power cable to the TV's power input and then to a standard electrical outlet (100-240 VAC 50-60 Hz).

CONNECTIVITY

Your Westinghouse Roku TV offers a variety of connectivity options for your devices:

- **HDMI Ports:** 4 (including 1 ARC port for audio return channel)
- **Composite Video Input:** 1
- **Optical Digital Audio Input:** 1
- **USB Ports:** 2 (1 x USB 2.0, 1 x USB 3.0)
- **Ethernet Port:** For wired internet connection
- **Wi-Fi:** Built-in for wireless internet access
- **Bluetooth:** For connecting compatible audio devices

These inputs allow you to connect cable boxes, game consoles, streaming sticks, sound bars, DVD/Blu-ray

players, or a digital antenna for local channels.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning the Screen

To clean the screen, gently wipe it with a soft, lint-free cloth. For stubborn marks, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-specific cleaning solution. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

General Care

Keep the TV in a well-ventilated area, away from direct sunlight, heat sources, and moisture. Do not block ventilation openings. Unplug the TV during lightning storms or when unused for extended periods.

TROUBLESHOOTING

No Power

- Ensure the power cable is securely connected to both the TV and the electrical outlet.
- Verify the outlet is functioning by plugging in another device.
- Check the power indicator light on the TV.

No Picture/Sound

- Confirm the correct input source is selected on the TV.
- Check all cable connections (HDMI, composite, etc.) for looseness.
- Adjust the volume on the TV and any connected audio devices.

Network Connectivity Issues

- Restart your router and modem.
- Go to the TV's network settings and re-scan for Wi-Fi networks or check the wired connection.
- Ensure the TV is within range of your Wi-Fi router.
