Introduction

The Peak Solice Pro is a lightweight, pen-style modular tattoo machine engineered for precision and comfort. Its key features include:

- Cordless Operation: Equipped with an 1800mAh PowerPack battery for up to 10 hours of tattooing power.
- Adjustable Stroke Length: Easily change stroke from 2.4mm to 4.2mm with a simple knob turn.
- Modular Design: Features a detachable PowerPack and an RCA module for wired setup flexibility.
- Lightweight Construction: Weighs only 7.2oz (with PowerPack) for comfortable extended use.
- Powerful Motor: Utilizes an 1827 coreless motor for consistent performance.

Components Included

Your Peak Solice Pro package includes the following items:

- 1 x Solice Pro Tattoo Machine Pen (main body)
- 1 x PowerPack Battery (1800mAh)
- 1 x RCA Module (for wired setup)
- 2 x Battery Pack Converters (3.5mm + RCA inputs)
- 3 x O-rings (spare)
- 2 x Allen Keys
- 1 x Spare Flywheel
- 1 x USB-C Charging Cable
- 1 x RCA Cord

Setup

Follow these steps to prepare your Solice Pro for use:

1. Attach Power Source:

- For Cordless Operation: Gently twist and attach the PowerPack battery to the top of the Solice Pro machine body until it is securely seated.
- For Wired Operation: Attach the RCA Module to the top of the Solice Pro machine body. Connect the provided RCA cord from the module to your preferred power supply.
- 2. Charge PowerPack (if using cordless): Connect the USB-C charging cable to the PowerPack and a suitable USB power adapter. The PowerPack display will indicate charging status. Ensure the PowerPack is fully charged before first use for optimal battery life.
- 3. **Insert Needle Cartridge:** Carefully insert your desired needle cartridge into the front opening of the machine until it clicks into place. Ensure it is seated firmly.

Operating Instructions

Once assembled and charged, you can begin operating your Solice Pro:

- 1. **Power On/Off:** Press and hold the power button on the PowerPack (or your external power supply if wired) to turn the machine on or off.
- 2. **Adjust Voltage:** Use the '+' and '-' buttons on the PowerPack display to adjust the operating voltage. The recommended operating voltage range is 4V to 12V, with a recommendation not to exceed 10V for prolonged periods.
- 3. **Adjust Needle Depth:** Rotate the grip of the machine to adjust the needle depth according to your preference and the specific needle cartridge being used.

Adjustable Stroke Feature

The Solice Pro features a unique adjustable stroke mechanism, allowing you to switch between different stroke lengths (2.4mm to 4.2mm) to suit various tattooing styles and techniques. To adjust the stroke:

- Locate the stroke adjustment knob on the machine body, typically below the PowerPack or RCA module.
- Gently turn the knob to select your desired stroke length. The markings on the machine indicate the available stroke options (e.g., 2.4mm, 3.3mm, 3.6mm, 3.9mm, 4.2mm).
- Ensure the knob is securely set at the chosen stroke length before operation.

Power Management

The included PowerPack provides up to 10 hours of cordless tattooing power, depending on voltage settings and usage. To maximize battery life and ensure consistent performance:

- Always fully charge the PowerPack before each tattooing session.
- Monitor the battery indicator on the PowerPack display during use.
- If the battery runs low during a session, you can switch to the RCA module and connect to a wired power supply to continue working without interruption.
- Use only the provided USB-C charging cable or a high-quality, compatible USB-C cable for charging.

Maintenance

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and hygiene of your Solice Pro machine:

- Cleaning: After each use, wipe down the exterior of the machine with a clean cloth and an approved disinfectant solution. Do not submerge the machine in liquid.
- **Lubrication:** Periodically apply a small amount of machine lubricant (specifically designed for tattoo machines) to moving parts as recommended by the manufacturer to ensure smooth operation.

- Storage: Store the machine in a clean, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect the machine for any signs of wear, damage, or loose components. If any issues are found, contact customer support.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your Solice Pro, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Machine does not turn on.	Low battery; PowerPack not attached correctly; RCA cable loose (wired).	Charge PowerPack; Ensure PowerPack/RCA module is securely attached; Check RCA cable connection.
Machine runs inconsistently or makes unusual noise.	Needle cartridge not seated correctly; Low voltage; Machine requires lubrication; Internal issue.	Re-seat needle cartridge; Increase voltage; Apply lubricant; Contact customer support if problem persists.
Battery life is shorter than expected.	High voltage usage; Frequent on/off cycles; Battery degradation over time.	Operate at lower voltage when possible; Ensure full charge before use; Battery replacement may be needed over time.
Stroke adjustment knob is stiff.	Debris or lack of lubrication.	Clean the area around the knob; Apply a small amount of machine lubricant.




