INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the user manual for your new Bonavita Enthusiast 8-Cup Drip Coffee Brewer. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your coffee machine. Designed for optimal coffee extraction, the Bonavita Enthusiast delivers barista-quality coffee with ease, featuring a thermal carafe and an optional pre-infusion mode for richer flavor.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all instructions carefully before using this appliance. Failure to follow these instructions may result in injury or damage to the appliance.

- Always unplug the coffee brewer from the electrical outlet before cleaning or when not in use.
- Do not immerse the appliance, cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.

- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- The thermal carafe is designed for use with this appliance only. It must never be used on a range top.
- Do not place the coffee brewer on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Do not use the appliance for other than intended use.

PARTS IDENTIFICATION

Familiarize yourself with the components of your Bonavita Enthusiast coffee brewer:

- A. Water Reservoir:** Detachable tank for water, with clear fill lines.
- B. Brew Basket:** Holds the coffee filter and grounds. Features a "pause & serve" mechanism.
- C. Showerhead:** Wide showerhead for even water distribution over coffee grounds.
- D. Thermal Carafe:** Stainless steel carafe designed to maintain coffee temperature.
- E. Control Panel:** Includes Power, Brew, Bloom, and Descale buttons.

SETUP

1. **Unpack and Clean:** Remove all packaging materials. Wash the carafe, brew basket, and water reservoir with warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry.
2. **Position the Brewer:** Place the coffee brewer on a flat, stable surface.
3. **Fill Water Reservoir:** Detach the water reservoir and fill it with fresh, cold water up to the desired level, using the fill lines for precise ratios. Reattach the reservoir securely.
4. **Insert Filter:** Place a paper filter (or reusable filter, if applicable) into the brew basket.
5. **Add Coffee Grounds:** Add your desired amount of coffee grounds to the filter.
6. **Secure Brew Basket and Carafe:** Ensure the filter basket is properly secured in its position. Place the lid on the carafe securely and position the carafe under the filter basket. It is crucial that the protrusion on the carafe lid engages the "pause & serve" mechanism under the filter basket for seamless coffee brewing and to prevent

overflow.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your Bonavita Enthusiast is designed for simple, one-touch operation.

Brewing Coffee:

1. Ensure the brewer is properly set up with water, filter, and coffee grounds.
2. Press the **Power** button to turn on the machine.
3. Press the **Brew** button to start the brewing cycle. The machine will brew a full pot (up to 8 cups) at optimal temperatures (194°–205°F / 90°–96°C) in under 7 minutes.
4. The "pause & serve" feature allows you to temporarily remove the carafe during brewing to pour a cup, though it's recommended to wait until the full brew cycle is complete for best results.

Using the Bloom Feature (Pre-infusion):

The optional Bloom mode gently pre-wets coffee grounds before brewing, allowing them to "bloom" and release gases, resulting in a richer, fuller extraction.

1. After setting up the brewer, press the **Power** button.
2. Press the **Bloom** button. The machine will pre-wet the grounds, pause briefly, and then continue with the full brewing cycle.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and taste.

Daily Cleaning:

- After each use, discard used coffee grounds and paper filter.
- Wash the brew basket, carafe, and carafe lid with warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly.
- The removable water reservoir can also be detached and cleaned with warm, soapy water.
- Wipe the exterior of the coffee brewer with a damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads.

Descaling:

Mineral deposits from water can build up over time, affecting performance. Descale your brewer regularly (e.g., every 1-3 months, depending on water hardness).

1. Fill the water reservoir with a descaling solution (e.g., white vinegar and water, or a commercial descaling agent) according to the solution's instructions.
2. Place an empty carafe with its lid under the brew basket.
3. Press the **Descale** button on the control panel. The machine will run a descaling cycle.
4. After the cycle, discard the descaling solution.
5. Run 2-3 cycles with fresh, clean water to rinse the machine thoroughly before brewing coffee again.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Coffee not brewing or brew basket overflowing.	Carafe lid not properly engaged with the "pause & serve" mechanism.	Ensure the carafe lid is correctly positioned and fully engages the mechanism under the brew basket.
Coffee tastes weak or too strong.	Incorrect coffee-to-water ratio or grind size.	Adjust coffee grounds amount or grind size. Refer to recommended ratios. Ensure water reservoir is filled to correct mark.
Brewer not turning on.	Not plugged in or power outlet issue.	Check power cord connection and try a different outlet.
Water leaking from reservoir.	Reservoir not seated correctly or damaged.	Ensure the removable water reservoir is firmly seated. Inspect for cracks or damage.
Brewing is slow.	Mineral buildup (scale).	Perform a descaling cycle as described in the Maintenance section.
