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1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the Qzanyee Life RMF-TX800U Voice Remote Control, designed as a replacement for various Sony Bravia Smart TV models. This remote offers voice control capabilities and dedicated app buttons for enhanced user experience.

2. SETUP

2.1 Battery Installation

The RMF-TX800U remote control requires two (2) new 1.5V AAA alkaline batteries for operation. Ensure correct polarity when inserting the batteries.

2.2 Pairing Instructions

To enable voice control and full functionality, the remote must be paired with your Sony Smart TV. Follow these steps for proper pairing:

1. **Step 1:** On your TV's homepage, navigate to **Settings**.

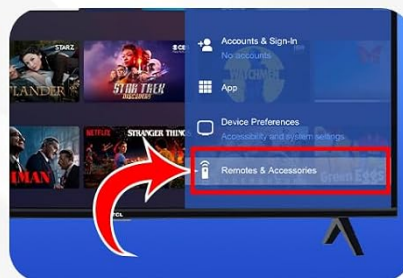
2. **Step 2:** Select **Remote & Accessories** from the Settings menu.
3. **Step 3:** Choose **Connect a new remote**.
4. **Step 4:** On the RMF-TX800U remote, press and hold the **Volume Down (-)** button and the **Microphone (Google Assistant)** button simultaneously for 3 seconds to initiate pairing.
5. **Step 5:** The TV display will show "Connecting..." indicating the pairing process is in progress.
6. **Step 6:** Once connected, a confirmation message will appear. Press the **OK** button on the remote to finalize pairing.

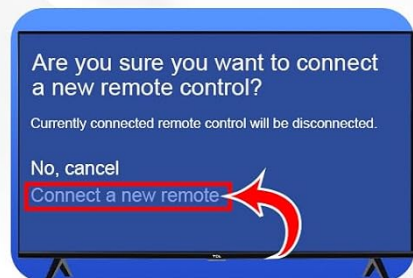
How to operate the RMF-TX800U remote control for proper pairing with your TV (The following specific detailed steps are explained)



STEP1:
Click Settings on the tv homepage



STEP2:
Select Remote & Accessories
→ Remote Control



STEP3:
Select Connect a new remote.



STEP4:
4. Press and hold the  and  for 3s to start pairing



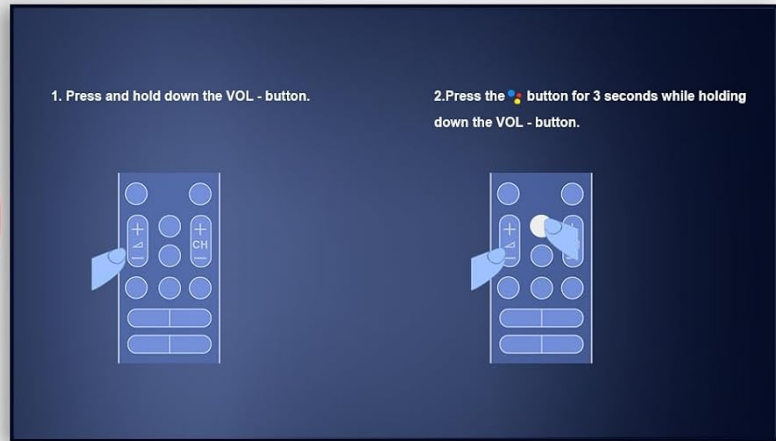
STEP5:
The display shows pairing in progress.

Press the Ok button to finish pairing.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Button Functions

Familiarize yourself with the functions of each button on your RMF-TX800U remote control:

- **Power (Green Button):** Turns the TV on or off, or sets it to standby/networked standby mode.
- **TV:** Switches to a TV channel or input, and displays the TV menu.
- **Microphone (MIC):** Activates the voice input feature. An LED above the microphone indicates activity.
- **Quick Settings (Gear Icon):** Displays Quick Settings for quick adjustments.
- **Input (Arrow into Box):** Displays and selects the input source.

- **123 (Control Menu):** Displays a menu on the TV to use functions not present on the remote.
- **Navigation D-Pad (Up/Down/Left/Right/Enter):** Navigates on-screen menus and selections.
- **BACK (Curved Arrow):** Returns to the previous screen.
- **HOME (House Icon):** Displays the TV Home Menu.
- **Volume (+/-):** Adjusts the volume level.
- **Google Assistant (Microphone Icon):** Accesses Google Assistant for voice commands and searches. Note: Google Assistant availability may vary by country/region.
- **Mute (Muted Speaker Icon):** Mutes the sound. Press again to restore sound.
- **CH+/- (Channel):** Selects the next or previous channel.
- **Play/Pause (Triangle/Two Vertical Bars):** Operates media content on the TV and connected BRAVIA Sync-compatible devices.
- **Guide (Three Horizontal Lines):** Displays the digital program guide for TV or cable/satellite box.



(Power)

Turns on or switches to standby/networked standby mode.

(TV)

Switch to a TV channel or input and display the TV menu. For details, refer to Using the TV menu page.

(MIC)

Speak into here to use the microphone in the remote control. There is an LED above the microphone.

(Quick Settings)

Display Quick Settings. For details, refer to Using the Quick Settings page.

(Input)

Display and select the input source, etc. For details, refer to Selecting inputs page.

123 (Control menu)

Display a menu on the TV to use button functions that are not on the remote control on the screen.

▲ (up)/ ▼ (Down)/ ◀ (Left)/ ▶ (Right)/ -⏏- (Enter) (Navigation D-Pad) on screen menu navigation and selection.

↶ (BACK) Return to the previous screen.

🏠 (HOME) Display the TV Home Menu For details, refer to Home menu page.

🔊 +/- (Volume) Adjust the volume.

🗨️ (Google Assistant)/ 🎤 (Microphone)

Ask Google for a little help on the big screen. Press the Google Assistant (or MIC) button on the remote to get started. For details, refer to Using the remote control microphone page. Google Assistant is not available in certain languages/countries/regions.

🔇 (Mute) Mute the sound. Press again to restore the sound.

Hint

- The accessibility shortcut service can be turned on or off by pressing and holding **🔇 (Mute)**.

CH+/- (Channel) Select the channel.

▶ (Play)/ || (Pause) Select the channel.

(Guide)

Display the digital program guide of the TV or cable/satellite box. For details, refer to Using the program guide page.

App buttons (online service)

Enjoy various video streaming services with one push. Press to watch your desired service.

3.2 Dedicated App Buttons

The remote features dedicated shortcut buttons for popular streaming applications, allowing quick access to your

desired services:

- **YouTube:** Direct access to the YouTube application.
- **Netflix:** Direct access to the Netflix application.
- **Disney+:** Direct access to the Disney+ application.
- **Prime Video:** Direct access to the Amazon Prime Video application.

3.3 Voice Control Usage

After successful pairing, you can use the voice control feature by pressing the Google Assistant (Microphone) button and speaking your command. Examples include:

- "Search [movie/show name]"
- "How's the weather today?"
- "Watch sports channels"
- "Play next episode"

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your RMF-TX800U remote control, please refer to the following common solutions:

- **Remote not responding:**
 - Ensure batteries are correctly installed and not depleted. Replace with new AAA alkaline batteries if necessary.
 - Verify that there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV's infrared receiver.
 - Re-attempt the pairing process as described in Section 2.2.
- **Voice control not working:**
 - Confirm the remote is successfully paired with the TV (refer to Section 2.2).
 - Ensure your TV's internet connection is stable, as voice commands often require online processing.
 - Check TV settings to ensure Google Assistant or voice input is enabled.
- **Specific buttons unresponsive:**
 - Clean the remote control surface, especially around the unresponsive button, to remove any debris.
 - If only certain app buttons are not working, ensure the corresponding apps are installed and updated on your TV.
