PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The PowerA Advantage Wired Controller for Xbox Series X|S with Lumectra is an officially licensed gamepad designed to enhance your gaming experience. It features customizable Multi-Zone RGB lighting, advanced gaming buttons, and precision controls for various gaming platforms.

Key Features:

- Multi-Zone RGB Lighting: Customize your controller with 4 individual lighting zones and 3 lighting modes for thousands of color combinations.
- Built-In IR Transmitter: Allows you to control compatible Lumectra Zone RGB lighting accessories directly from your gamepad.
- Advanced Gaming Buttons: Two mappable buttons for on-the-fly programming without system settings.
- 3-Way Trigger Locks: Adjust trigger travel distance for quicker actions in FPS games or full throttle in racing.
- Dual Rumble Motors: Provides tactile feedback for immersive gaming.
- Immersive Impulse Triggers: Reactive rumble sensations for enhanced action.
- Smooth Controls: Precision-tuned analog sticks and anti-friction rings.
- Headset Compatible: 3.5 mm stereo headset jack.

SETUP

The PowerA Advantage Wired Controller is designed for simple plug-and-play setup.

1. **Connect the USB-C Cable:** Insert the smaller USB-C end of the included 10ft cable into the port on the top of the controller.

2. **Connect to Console/PC:** Plug the standard USB-A end of the cable into an available USB port on your Xbox Series X|S, Xbox One, or Windows 10/11 PC.
The controller will automatically be recognized by your system. No additional drivers are typically required for basic functionality.
3. **Headset Connection (Optional):** If desired, plug your 3.5 mm compatible headset into the stereo headset jack located at the bottom of the controller.

This allows for in-game audio and microphone use. Volume and mute controls can be adjusted via the controller's dedicated buttons.

OPERATING THE CONTROLLER

Basic Controls:

The controller features a standard Xbox layout with precision-tuned analog sticks, a D-pad, and face buttons (A, B, X, Y).

Customizing RGB Lighting (Lumectra):

The controller features Multi-Zone RGB lighting with 4 individual lighting zones and 3 modes (Solid, Breathing, Cycle) for thousands of color combinations.



- To change lighting modes or colors, use the dedicated buttons on the back of the controller.
- The built-in IR transmitter allows control of compatible Lumectra Zone RGB lighting accessories directly from the gamepad.

Advanced Gaming Buttons:

The controller includes two mappable Advanced Gaming Buttons on the back for quick, on-the-fly programming.



3-WAY TRIGGER LOCKS AND MAPPABLE ADVANCED GAMING BUTTONS

- To map a button: Hold down the program button on the back, press the button you want to map (e.g., A, B, X, Y, shoulder buttons), then press the Advanced Gaming Button you wish to assign it to.
- This allows for quick execution of complex actions without moving your thumbs from the analog sticks.

3-Way Trigger Locks:

Adjust the travel distance of the triggers (LT/RT) with three different positions to optimize response time for different game genres.

- Use the physical switches on the back of the controller to select the desired trigger travel distance.
- Shorter travel is ideal for faster firing in FPS games, while full travel is best for precise acceleration in racing games.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your PowerA Advantage Wired Controller, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe down the controller regularly. For stubborn grime, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild electronics cleaner. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** Store the controller in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Avoid wrapping the cable tightly around the controller to prevent damage.
- **Cable Care:** Handle the USB-C cable with care. Avoid sharp bends or excessive pulling, especially at the connectors, to prevent internal wire damage.
- **Avoid Drops:** While designed for durability, repeated drops can damage internal components. Handle the controller with care during use and storage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your PowerA Advantage Wired Controller, try the following solutions:

Problem	Solution
Controller not responding/not turning on.	<p>Ensure the USB-C cable is securely connected to both the controller and the console/PC.</p> <p>Try connecting the controller to a different USB port on your console/PC.</p> <p>Test the controller on another console/PC if available to rule out system-specific issues.</p> <p>Verify the cable is not damaged by trying a different compatible USB-C cable.</p>
Stick drift or inaccurate analog stick input.	<p>Calibrate the analog sticks using the PowerA Gamer HQ App.</p> <p>Ensure the controller's firmware is up to date via the PowerA Gamer HQ App.</p> <p>Clean around the base of the analog sticks with compressed air to remove any debris.</p>
Buttons not responding or sticking.	<p>Ensure no debris is lodged under the buttons.</p> <p>Test button functionality using the PowerA Gamer HQ App.</p>
Headset audio issues.	<p>Ensure the 3.5 mm headset plug is fully inserted into the controller's jack.</p> <p>Check headset volume and mute settings on the controller and within your console/PC's audio settings.</p> <p>Test the headset with another device to confirm it is functioning correctly.</p>


