1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the MAXLANDER 20V 4.0Ah Lithium Rechargeable Battery Pack. This manual provides important information regarding the safe operation, charging, and maintenance of your battery pack. Please read it thoroughly before first use and retain it for future reference.

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- **Use Compatible Chargers:** Only use MAXLANDER 20V compatible chargers specifically designed for this battery pack. Using an incompatible charger may result in fire, electric shock, or battery damage.
- **Avoid Water Exposure:** Do not immerse the battery pack in water or expose it to rain or wet conditions. Water entering the battery pack can increase the risk of electric shock or short circuit.
- **Temperature Control:** Do not expose the battery pack to extreme temperatures (above 104°F / 40°C or below 32°F / 0°C). Avoid direct sunlight.
- **Prevent Short Circuits:** Do not short-circuit the battery terminals. Keep the battery pack away from metal objects that could make a connection between the terminals.
- **Proper Disposal:** Dispose of battery packs responsibly according to local regulations. Do not dispose of in household waste or by incineration.
- **Keep Away from Children:** Store the battery pack out of reach of children.

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

5. SETUP: CHARGING THE BATTERY

Before first use, and after each period of discharge, fully charge the battery pack. Use only a MAXLANDER 20V compatible charger (sold separately).

1. Connect the compatible MAXLANDER charger to a standard electrical outlet.
2. Slide the battery pack onto the charger until it clicks securely into place.
3. Observe the charger's indicator lights. These lights typically show the charging status (e.g., charging, fully charged, error). Refer to your specific charger's manual for detailed light patterns.
4. Once the battery pack is fully charged, remove it from the charger.

6. OPERATING: INSERTING AND REMOVING THE BATTERY

This battery pack is designed for use with MAXLANDER 20V cordless tools.

Inserting the Battery Pack

Align the battery pack with the battery port on your MAXLANDER 20V tool. Slide the battery pack into the port until it locks securely into place. Ensure it is firmly seated before operating the tool. A click sound indicates proper engagement.

Removing the Battery Pack

To remove the battery pack, locate and press the battery release button (typically found on the battery pack or the tool itself). While holding the button, slide the battery pack out of the tool's port.

7. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and performance of your battery pack.

Cleaning

Keep the battery pack clean and free of debris. Use a dry, soft cloth to wipe the exterior. Do not use liquids, solvents, or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the battery casing or internal components.

Storage

Store the battery pack in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. For long-term storage, it is recommended to charge the battery to approximately 50-70% capacity. Avoid storing the battery pack fully discharged or fully charged for extended periods, as this can reduce its overall lifespan.

Inspection

Regularly inspect the battery pack for any signs of damage, such as cracks, leaks, swelling, or corrosion on the terminals. Do not use a damaged battery pack; contact MAXLANDER customer service for assistance.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Battery Not Charging:**

- Ensure the charger is properly plugged into a working electrical outlet.
- Verify the battery pack is correctly seated on the charger.
- Check for any visible damage to the battery pack or charger.
- Ensure the ambient temperature is within the recommended charging range (typically 40°F to 104°F / 5°C to 40°C).

- **Tool Not Operating with Battery:**

- Ensure the battery pack is fully charged.
- Verify the battery pack is securely inserted into the tool.
- Check for any obstructions or damage to the tool's battery terminals.
- Confirm the battery pack is compatible with your specific MAXLANDER 20V tool model.
