## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides essential information for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your HP Victus 15.6" Full HD 144Hz Gaming Laptop. Designed for high-performance computing and gaming, this laptop features an AMD Ryzen 5 7535HS processor, NVIDIA GeForce RTX 2050 graphics, 8GB DDR5 RAM, and a 512GB SSD. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure proper use and longevity of your device.

## 2. INITIAL SETUP

---

### 2.1 Connecting to Power

Before first use, connect the laptop to a power outlet using the provided power adapter. The battery will begin charging automatically. It is recommended to fully charge the battery before initial use.

### 2.2 First Boot and Windows Setup

1. Press the power button located on the keyboard deck to turn on the laptop.
2. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the Windows 11 Home setup process. This includes selecting your region, language, connecting to a Wi-Fi network, and creating a user account.
3. Allow the system to download and install any necessary updates after the initial setup is complete. This may require a restart.

## 3. OPERATING YOUR LAPTOP

---

### 3.1 Display and Graphics

The laptop features a 15.6-inch Full HD (1920x1080) display with a 144Hz refresh rate. This high refresh rate, combined with adaptive sync technology, minimizes screen tearing and provides a smoother visual experience, particularly beneficial for gaming. The NVIDIA GeForce RTX 2050 graphics card handles visual processing.

## 3.2 Keyboard and Touchpad

The HP Victus laptop includes a backlit keyboard with an integrated numeric pad. The backlighting can be adjusted or toggled using function keys (refer to your laptop's specific function key layout). The precision touchpad supports multi-touch gestures for navigation.

## 3.3 Audio and Camera

The laptop is equipped with integrated speakers and an HP Wide Vision HD Camera, suitable for video calls and online meetings. Microphone input is available via the combined audio jack.

## 3.4 Connectivity

The laptop supports wireless connectivity via Bluetooth. For wired connections, it includes multiple USB 3.0 ports and an Ethernet port. An HDMI port allows connection to external displays.

## 3.5 Performance and Storage

Powered by an AMD Ryzen 5 7535HS processor and 8GB of DDR5 RAM, the laptop is capable of handling demanding applications and games. The 512GB SSD provides fast boot times and quick application loading. For users requiring more storage, external drives can be connected via USB ports.

# 4. MAINTENANCE

---

## 4.1 Cleaning Your Laptop

- **Screen:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a screen cleaner. Do not spray liquid directly onto the screen.
- **Keyboard and Chassis:** Use a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth can be used, ensuring no liquid enters openings. Compressed air can remove dust from keyboard crevices.
- **Ports:** Ensure ports are free of dust and debris. Use compressed air if necessary.

## 4.2 Software Updates

Regularly update your Windows operating system, drivers (especially graphics drivers), and HP software to ensure optimal performance, security, and compatibility. Updates can be managed through Windows Update and the HP Support Assistant application.

## 4.3 Battery Care

To maximize battery lifespan:

- Avoid extreme temperatures.
- Do not leave the laptop plugged in constantly at 100% charge for extended periods.
- Allow the battery to discharge partially before recharging.

## 5.1 Common Issues and Solutions

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |

| Problem                  | Possible Cause                                  | Solution   |

| Laptop does not power on | No power, discharged battery                    | Ensure power adapter is securely connected and outlet is functional. Charge battery for at least 30 minutes.     |
| Screen is blank or black | Display issue, sleep mode                       | Press any key or move mouse to wake from sleep. Check external display connection if applicable. Restart laptop. |
| Wi-Fi not connecting     | Incorrect password, router issue, driver issue  | Verify Wi-Fi password. Restart router. Update Wi-Fi drivers via Device Manager.                                  |
| Slow performance         | Too many programs open, low disk space, malware | Close unnecessary applications. Free up disk space. Run antivirus scan. Check for system updates.                |
| Overheating              | Blocked vents, heavy workload                   | Ensure vents are clear and laptop is on a hard, flat surface. Reduce workload or use a cooling pad.              |

## 5.2 System Recovery

If software issues persist, you may need to perform a system recovery. Windows 11 offers options to reset your PC, which can reinstall Windows while keeping your files or removing everything. Access these options via **Settings > System > Recovery**.
