1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Cecotec ProClean 5110 Retro Green Digital Microwave with Grill. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient use of your appliance. Please read it thoroughly before first use and keep it for future reference.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons, including the following:

- · Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Ensure the voltage indicated on the appliance corresponds to your local mains voltage.
- Do not operate the microwave if the door or door seals are damaged. Contact qualified service personnel.
- Do not heat liquids or other foods in sealed containers as they are liable to explode.
- Only allow children to use the oven without supervision when adequate instructions have been given so that the child is able to use the oven in a safe way and understands the hazards of improper use.
- Do not use corrosive chemicals or vapors in this appliance.
- Regularly clean the microwave and remove any food deposits. Failure to maintain the oven in a clean condition could lead to deterioration of the surface that could adversely affect the life of the appliance and possibly result in a hazardous situation.
- Do not immerse the appliance, power cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Always ensure proper ventilation around the microwave.
- · Use only utensils suitable for microwave ovens.

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the main parts of your microwave oven.

Components:

- Door Handle: For opening and closing the microwave door.
- Viewing Window: Allows you to monitor food during cooking.
- Control Panel: Digital display and buttons for setting functions.
- Rotary Dial: Used to adjust time, weight, or select programs.
- Turntable: Glass plate that rotates to ensure even cooking.
- Turntable Support: Holds the turntable in place.
- Grill Rack: Used for grilling food.

5. SETUP

5.1 Unpacking and Placement

1. Remove all packaging materials and accessories. Inspect the microwave for any damage, such as dents or

- a broken door. Do not operate if damaged.
- 2. Place the microwave on a flat, stable surface that can support its weight and the heaviest food likely to be cooked in it.
- 3. Ensure adequate ventilation: leave a minimum of 20 cm (8 inches) of space above the oven, 10 cm (4 inches) at the rear, and 5 cm (2 inches) on both sides. Do not block any ventilation openings.

5.2 Turntable Assembly

- 1. Place the turntable support ring in the center of the microwave cavity.
- 2. Position the glass turntable on top of the support ring, ensuring it sits securely in the center hub.

5.3 Initial Cleaning

Before first use, wipe the interior and exterior of the microwave with a damp cloth. Ensure the turntable and grill rack are clean.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your Cecotec ProClean 5110 microwave offers various cooking functions. Always ensure the door is securely closed before starting any operation.

6.1 Setting the Clock

Upon plugging in, the display will show '0:00'.

- 1. Press the 'Clock' button (if available, otherwise consult the specific button for time setting).
- 2. Use the rotary dial to set the hour. Press 'Confirm' or 'Start'.
- 3. Use the rotary dial to set the minutes. Press 'Confirm' or 'Start' again.

6.2 Microwave Cooking

The microwave has 5 power levels and a maximum power of 700W.

- 1. Place food in a microwave-safe container on the glass turntable.
- 2. Close the door.
- 3. Press the 'Microwave' button or select the desired power level using the control panel.
- 4. Use the rotary dial to set the cooking time (up to 60 minutes).
- 5. Press the 'Start' button. The microwave will beep at the end of the cooking cycle.



6.3 Grill Function

The grill function is ideal for browning and crisping food.

- 1. Place food on the grill rack, which should be placed on the glass turntable.
- 2. Close the door.
- 3. Press the 'Grill' button.
- 4. Use the rotary dial to set the grilling time.
- 5. Press the 'Start' button.

6.4 Defrost Mode

The defrost mode allows for perfect defrosting based on food type.

- 1. Place the frozen food on the glass turntable.
- 2. Close the door.
- 3. Press the 'Defrost' button.
- 4. Use the rotary dial to select the weight or time for defrosting.
- 5. Press the 'Start' button.

6.5 Automatic Cooking Programs

The microwave features 8 automatic cooking programs for convenience.

- 1. Place food in the microwave.
- 2. Close the door.
- 3. Press the 'Auto Menu' or 'Program' button repeatedly to cycle through the 8 programs, or use the dial to select.
- 4. The display will show the program number or food type.
- 5. Press 'Start'. The microwave will automatically set the appropriate cooking time and power level.

6.6 Child Safety Lock

To prevent unsupervised operation by children, activate the child safety lock.

- To activate: Press and hold the 'Stop/Cancel' button for 3 seconds. A lock indicator will appear on the display.
- To deactivate: Press and hold the 'Stop/Cancel' button for 3 seconds again. The lock indicator will disappear.

7. CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning helps maintain the performance and longevity of your microwave.

7.1 Exterior Cleaning

Wipe the exterior surface with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

7.2 Interior Cleaning

- 1. After each use, wipe the interior with a damp cloth to remove food splatters.
- 2. For stubborn stains, place a bowl of water with lemon slices inside and microwave on high for 5-10 minutes. The steam will loosen the stains, making them easier to wipe away.
- 3. Clean the door seals and surrounding areas regularly to ensure proper closure.

7.3 Turntable and Grill Rack

The glass turntable and grill rack can be washed in warm, soapy water or in a dishwasher. Ensure they are completely dry before placing them back in the microwave.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your microwave, refer to the following table for common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Microwave does not start	Power cord not plugged in; Door not closed properly; Child lock activated.	Ensure plug is securely in outlet; Close door firmly; Deactivate child lock.
Food not heating evenly	Food not stirred or rotated; Incorrect power level/time; Turntable not rotating.	Stir or rearrange food during cooking; Adjust power/time; Check turntable assembly.
Unusual noise during operation	Turntable not correctly placed; Foreign object in cavity.	Re-position turntable; Remove any obstructions.
Smoke or sparks inside	Metal in microwave; Food residue; Damaged interior.	Immediately turn off and unplug. Remove metal objects. Clean interior. If damage persists, contact service.
