DWVO Mirrored Vanity Table Set with Tri-Folding Mirror Instruction Manual

Model: Makeup Vanity

1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all instructions before assembly and use of this product. Keep this manual for future reference.

- Ensure all parts are present and undamaged before assembly. Do not use if any parts are missing or broken.
- Assemble the vanity set on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
- Place the assembled vanity on a flat, stable, and level surface to prevent tipping.
- Do not allow children to climb on or play with the vanity set.
- Avoid placing excessively heavy items on the vanity top or inside the drawers.
- Keep away from direct heat sources or open flames.
- Use caution when handling mirrored surfaces to prevent breakage or injury.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components listed below are included in your package:

- Mirrored Vanity Table
- Tri-Folding Mirror Unit
- Cushioned Stool
- Assembly Hardware (screws, Allen wrench, etc.)
- Instruction Manual




Figure 2.1: This image illustrates the overall dimensions of the vanity table and accompanying stool. The vanity measures approximately 41 inches wide, 19 inches deep, and 55 inches high (including the mirror). The stool is approximately 20 inches wide, 16 inches deep, and 19 inches high.

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

The DWVO Mirrored Vanity Table Set is designed for easy assembly, with many components pre-assembled for your convenience.

Step 1: Unpacking

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Inspect each part for any signs of damage. If any parts are damaged or missing, do not proceed with assembly and contact customer service.

Step 2: Mirror Attachment

The tri-folding mirror unit is typically separate from the vanity table. Carefully place the mirror unit onto the designated area on the vanity tabletop. Ensure it is securely seated in the grooves or aligned with any pre-drilled holes for attachment. Use the provided hardware (if any) to secure the mirror unit firmly to the vanity

table.

Step 3: Stool Assembly

The cushioned stool may require leg attachment. Turn the stool seat upside down. Align each leg with the pre-drilled holes on the underside of the stool. Insert the provided screws and tighten them securely using the included Allen wrench or appropriate tool. Ensure all legs are firmly attached and stable.

Step 4: Final Placement

Once assembled, carefully move the vanity table and stool to your desired location. Ensure it is placed on a flat, stable surface to prevent wobbling. Adjust any leveling feet if present to ensure stability.




Figure 3.1: This diagram demonstrates the versatility of the tri-folding mirror. It can be unfolded for a wide viewing angle, folded inwards for compact storage, or completely disassembled from the vanity top to convert the unit into a writing desk.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This section provides guidance on using the features of your DWVO Mirrored Vanity Table Set.

Using the Tri-Folding Mirror

The side panels of the tri-folding mirror are hinged, allowing them to be adjusted. You can angle them inwards

or outwards to achieve various viewing perspectives, which is ideal for applying makeup or styling hair from different angles. For a more compact setup or to use the vanity as a writing desk, the side mirrors can be folded completely inwards. The entire mirror unit can also be removed if desired, transforming the vanity into a standalone desk.

Drawer Functionality

The vanity table features two large storage drawers equipped with silent metal slides for smooth and quiet operation. These drawers are ideal for organizing cosmetics, jewelry, hair accessories, and other personal items. The interior of the drawers is lined with black fabric to protect your belongings from scratches and provide a luxurious feel.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper care will ensure the longevity and appearance of your vanity set.

Cleaning the Vanity Surface

- For routine cleaning, wipe the mirrored surfaces and gold metal frame with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth.
- For more thorough cleaning, use a damp cloth with a mild glass cleaner. Spray the cleaner onto the cloth, not directly onto the mirror or frame, to avoid streaks or damage.
- Avoid using abrasive cleaners, harsh chemicals, or rough sponges, as these can scratch or damage the mirrored finish and metal frame.

Stool Care

- The velvet seat material can be spot cleaned with a damp cloth and a small amount of mild detergent if necessary. Blot the stain gently; do not rub vigorously.

- Avoid saturating the fabric with water. Allow to air dry completely.

General Care

- Avoid placing hot items directly on the mirrored surface. Use coasters or protective pads if necessary.
- Do not overload the drawers, as this can affect their smooth operation and potentially damage the slides.
- Regularly check and tighten any screws or fasteners to ensure the stability of the vanity and stool.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your vanity set.

Mirror Appears Loose or Unstable

- Ensure the tri-folding mirror unit is correctly seated in the designated grooves on the vanity tabletop.
- If applicable, check that any attachment hardware securing the mirror to the table is tightened.

Drawers Not Sliding Smoothly

- Check for any obstructions inside the drawer or along the drawer slides.
- Ensure the drawers are not overloaded, which can cause them to stick or become misaligned.
- Verify that the vanity table is on a level surface, as an uneven surface can affect drawer alignment.

Vanity or Stool Wobbles

- Confirm that the vanity and stool are placed on a flat, even surface.
- Check and tighten all assembly screws on both the vanity and the stool.
- If present, adjust any leveling feet on the bottom of the legs to compensate for uneven flooring.
