## 1. INTRODUCTION

## 2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

- 1 x Children's Kitchen structure
- 1 x Pot with Lid
- 1 x Frying Pan
- 3 x Kitchen Utensils (e.g., ladle, spatula)
- 1 x Instruction Manual

Additional accessories such as a retro telephone, microwave, oven, water dispenser, and storage cabinets are integrated into the main kitchen structure.

## 3. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly is required for this product. Please follow the detailed instructions provided in the included manual. It is recommended to assemble the kitchen on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches. Ensure all screws and fasteners are securely tightened, but do not overtighten.

**Tools Required:** A screwdriver (not included) will be necessary for assembly.

**Important:** Adult supervision is recommended during assembly. Keep small parts away from young children before and during assembly.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 4.1 Realistic Lights and Sounds

The toy kitchen features realistic lights and sounds to enhance the play experience. To activate these features:

- **Stove Burners:** Turn the knobs on the stove to activate cooking sounds and lights, simulating a real stovetop.
- **Water Dispenser:** Press the button on the water dispenser to produce realistic water dispensing sounds.

**Battery Installation:** The water dispenser requires 3 AAA batteries (not included). Ensure batteries are inserted with correct polarity. Refer to the battery compartment for specific instructions.

## 4.2 Functional Features

- **Oven and Microwave:** Doors open and close, allowing for imaginative baking and cooking scenarios.
- **Water Dispenser:** The dispenser is designed to simulate water flow (requires batteries).
- **Retro Telephone:** A decorative telephone is included for role-play communication.
- **Sink and Faucet:** The sink is removable for easy cleaning, and the faucet handles can be turned.
- **Storage:** Ample storage space, including a top small cabinet, hooks for hanging utensils, and a bottom large cabinet, encourages children to organize their play area.



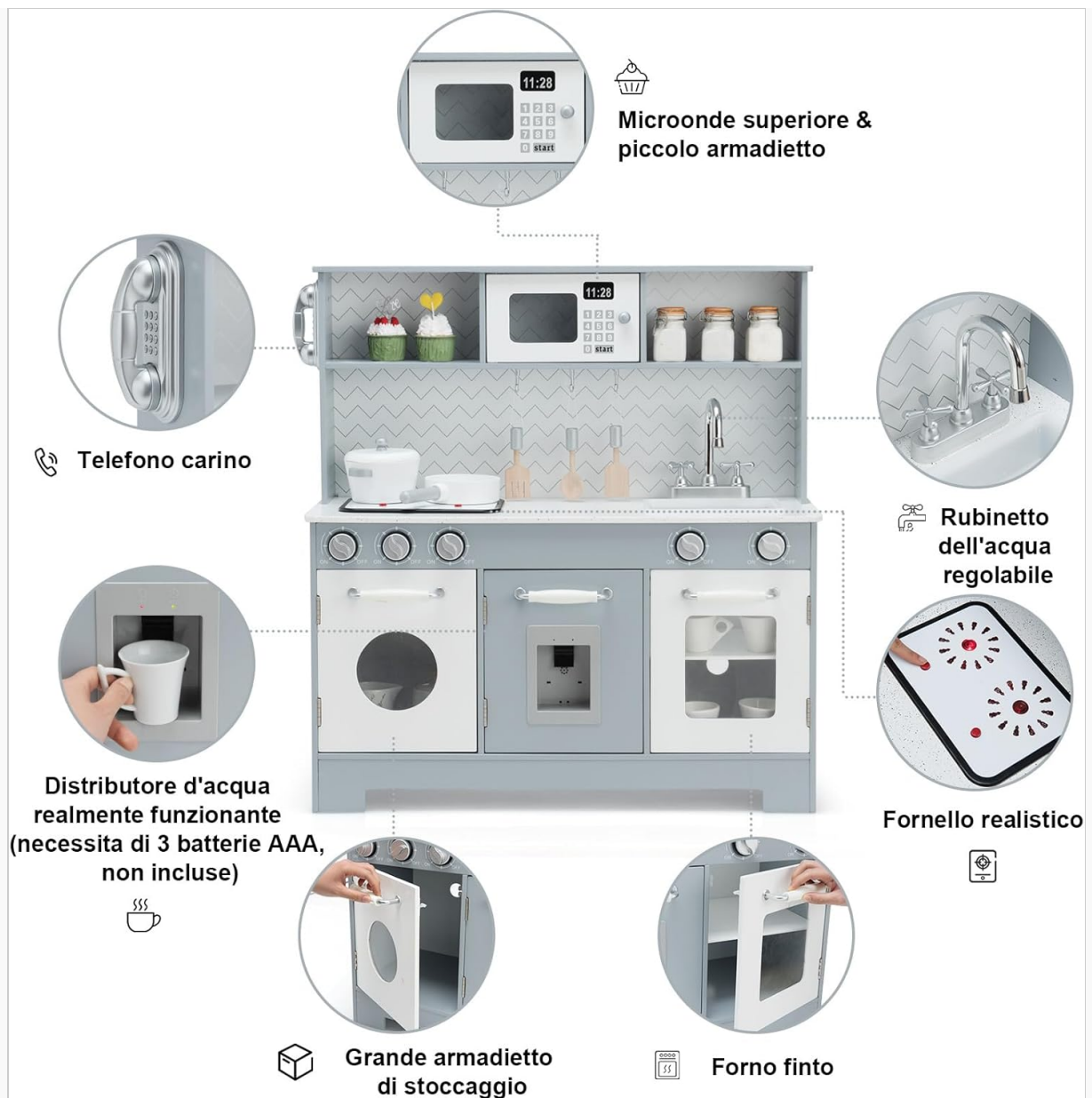


Image 4.2: An exploded view highlighting key features such as the microwave, telephone, water dispenser, realistic stove, and storage compartments.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the wood or paint finish.
- **Drying:** Ensure the kitchen is thoroughly dry after cleaning to prevent moisture damage to the wood.
- **Storage:** Store the toy kitchen in a dry environment, away from direct sunlight or extreme temperatures, to preserve its material integrity.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all screws and connections to ensure they remain tight. Retighten if necessary.
- **Battery Replacement:** Replace AAA batteries in the water dispenser as needed. Always use new batteries and dispose of old ones responsibly.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Lights/Sounds Not Working:**
  - Check if the water dispenser has fresh AAA batteries installed correctly.
  - Ensure the stove knobs are fully turned to the 'ON' position.

- **Loose Parts:** If any parts feel loose, gently tighten the corresponding screws. Do not overtighten.
- **Difficulty During Assembly:** Refer to the detailed assembly instructions provided. Ensure all pieces are oriented correctly before attempting to fasten them. If issues persist, contact customer support.
